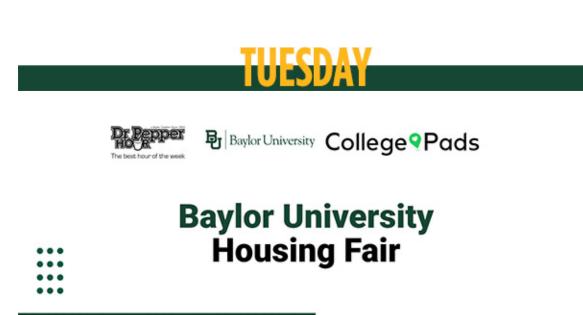


Majors Fair
