Black Student Welcome

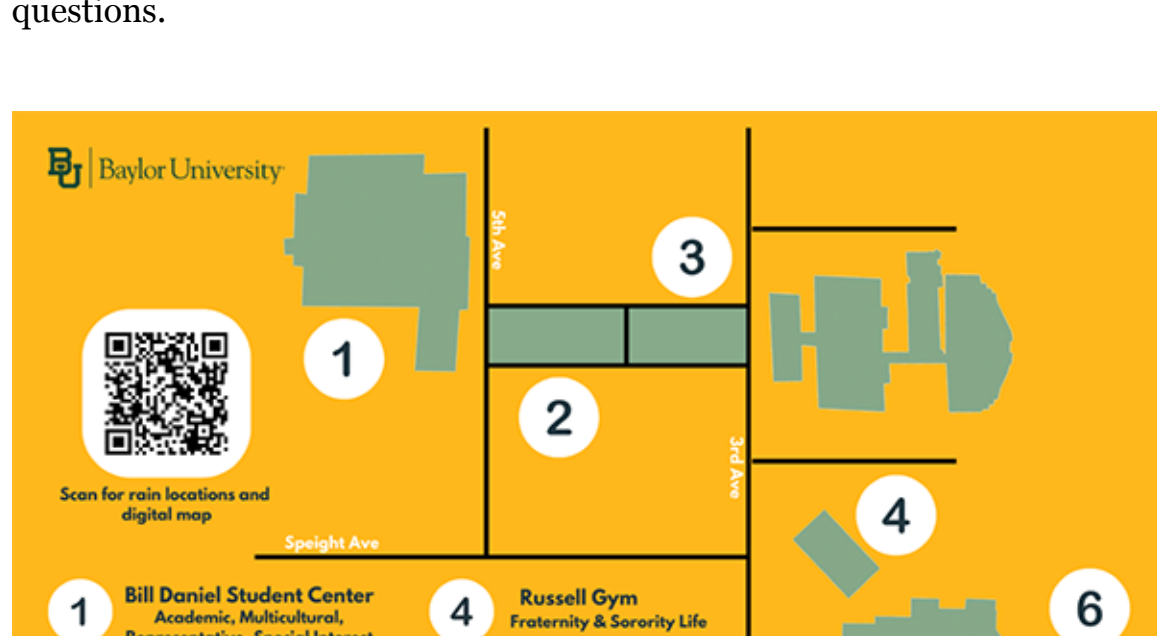

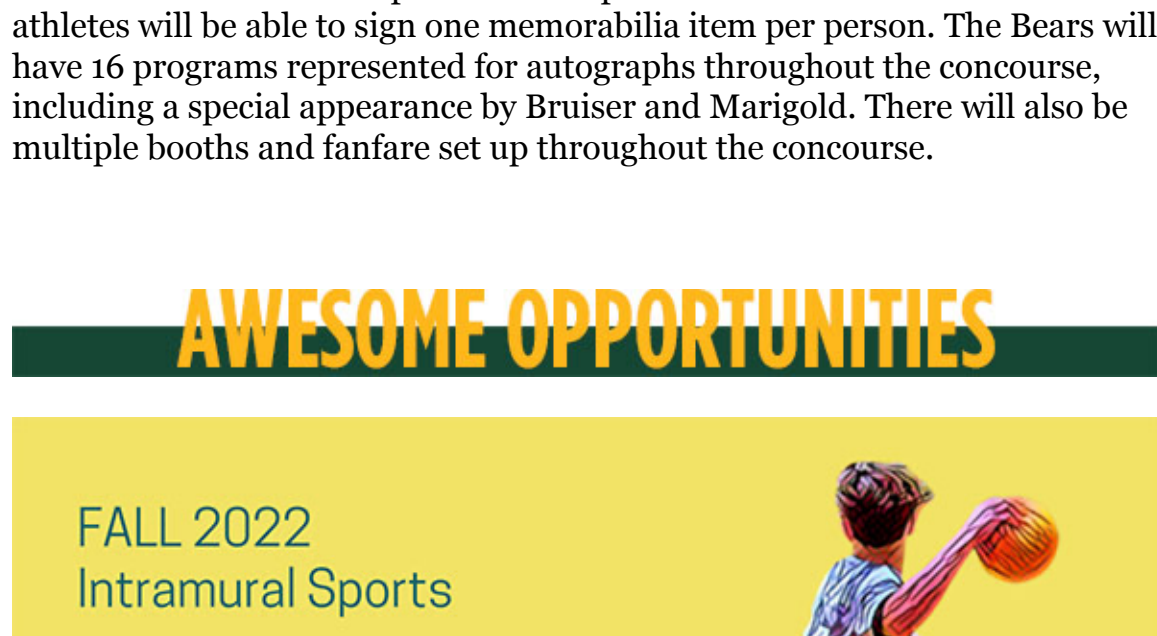


Late Night (For NEW Students)

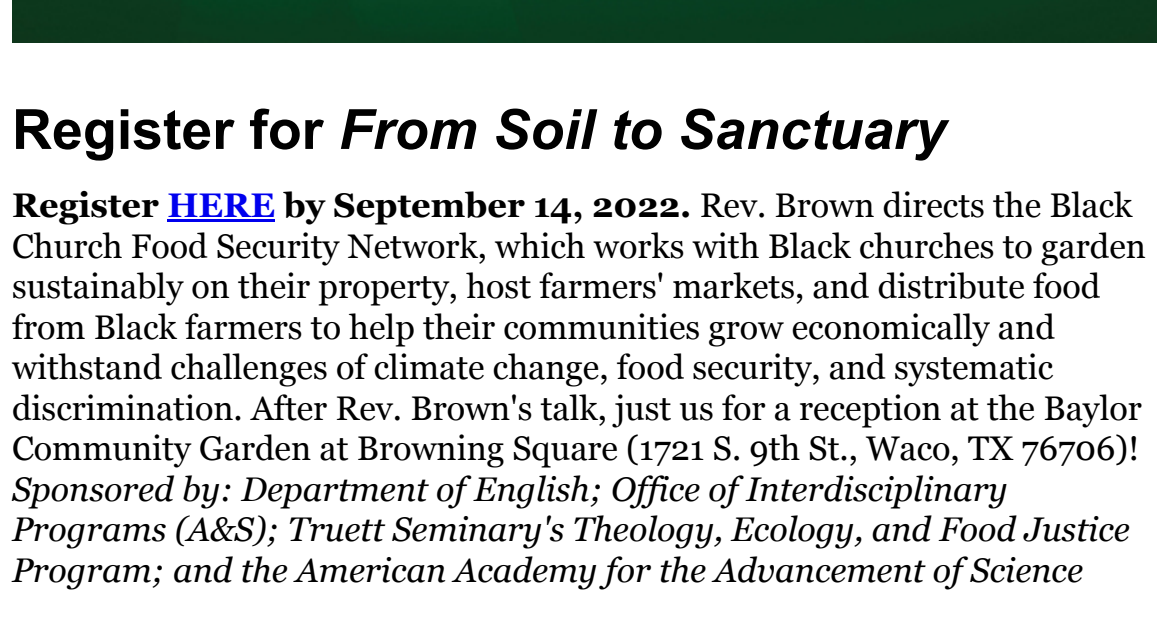


Intramural Sports Play Pass

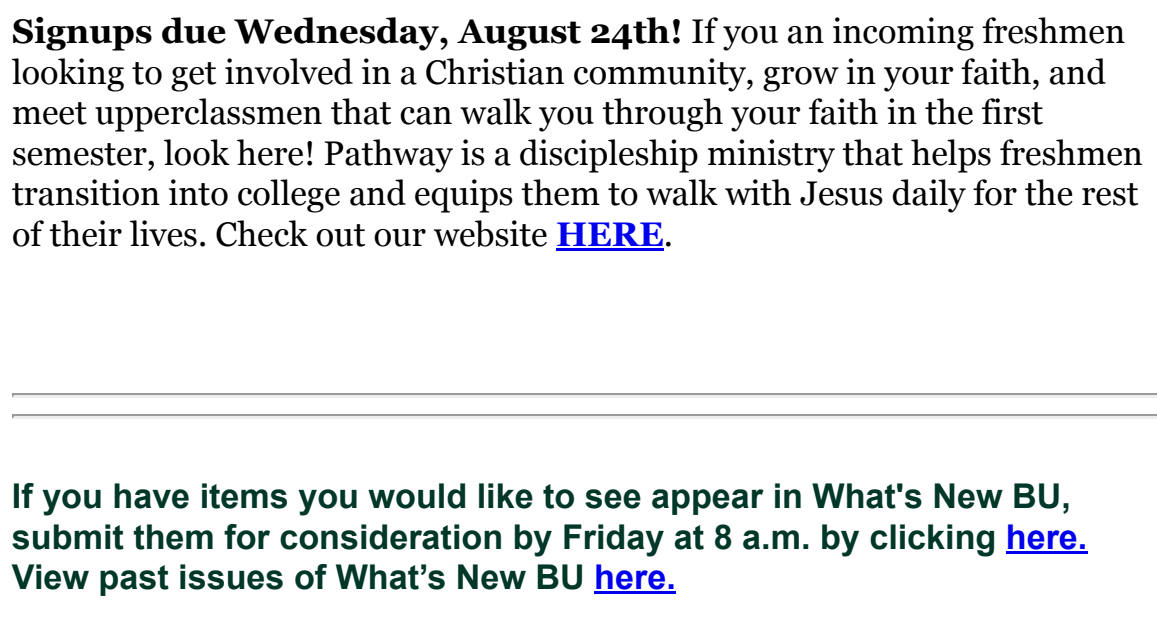
