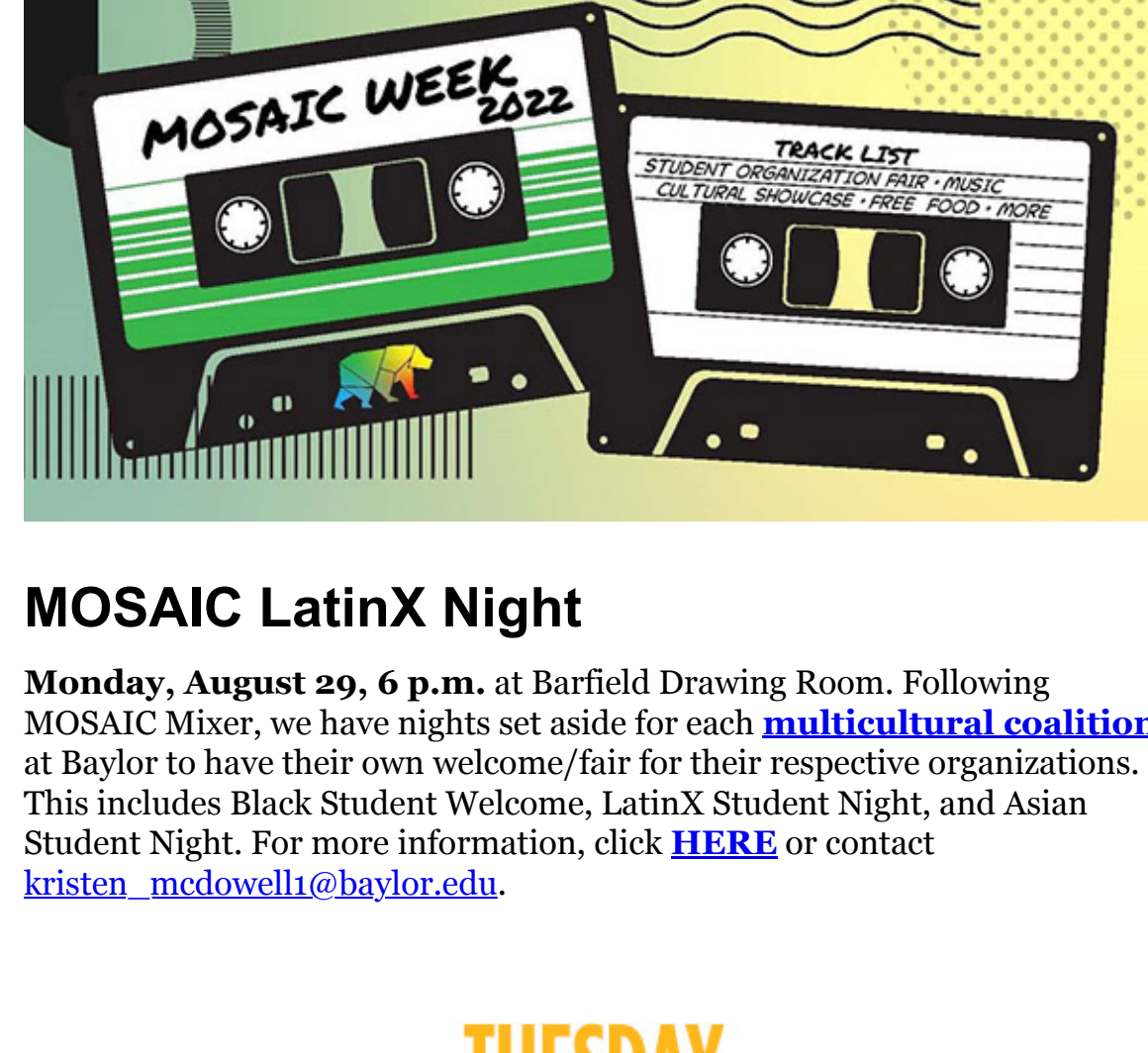

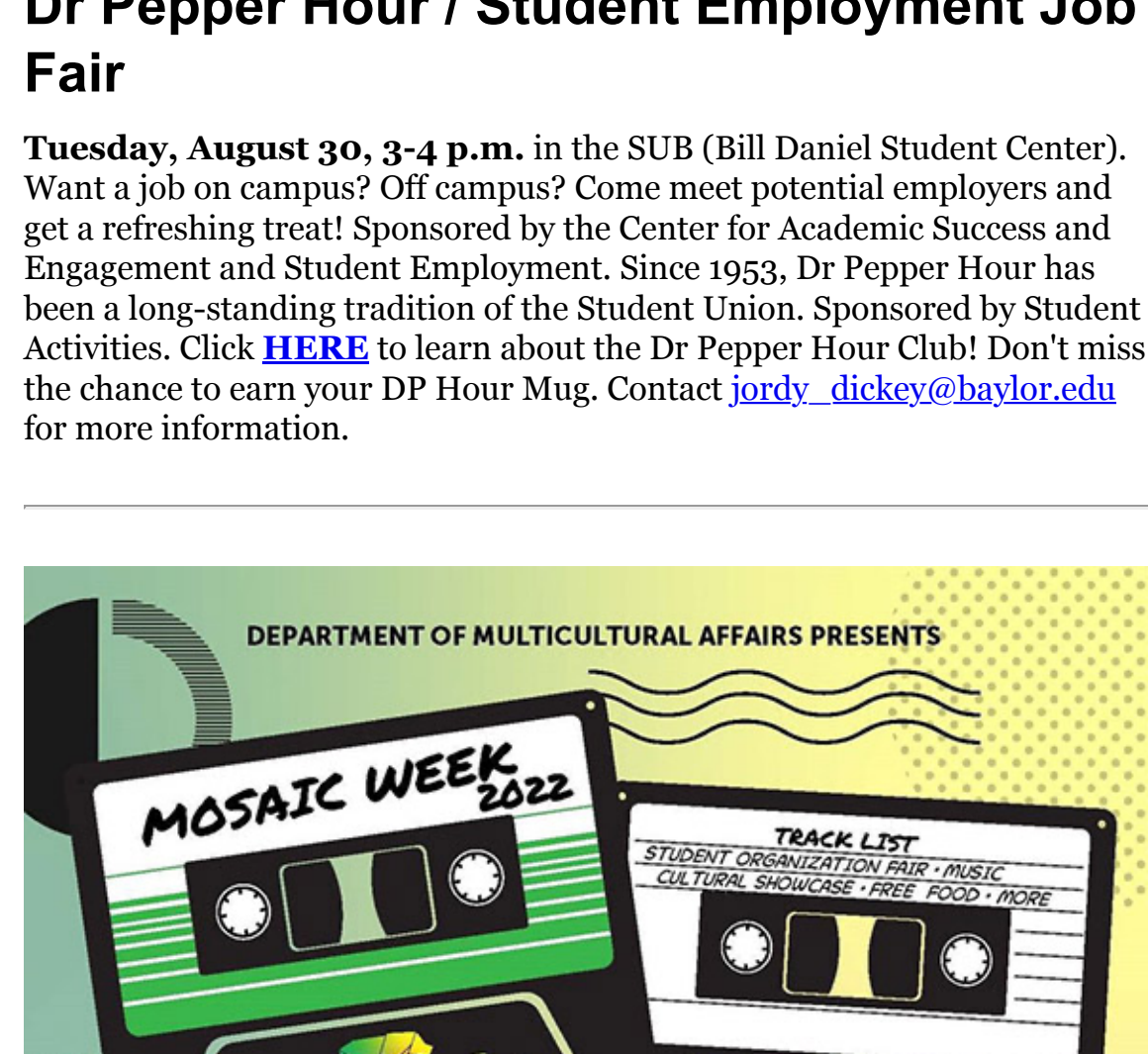
Secure Your Student Football Ticket

First Belay Clinic

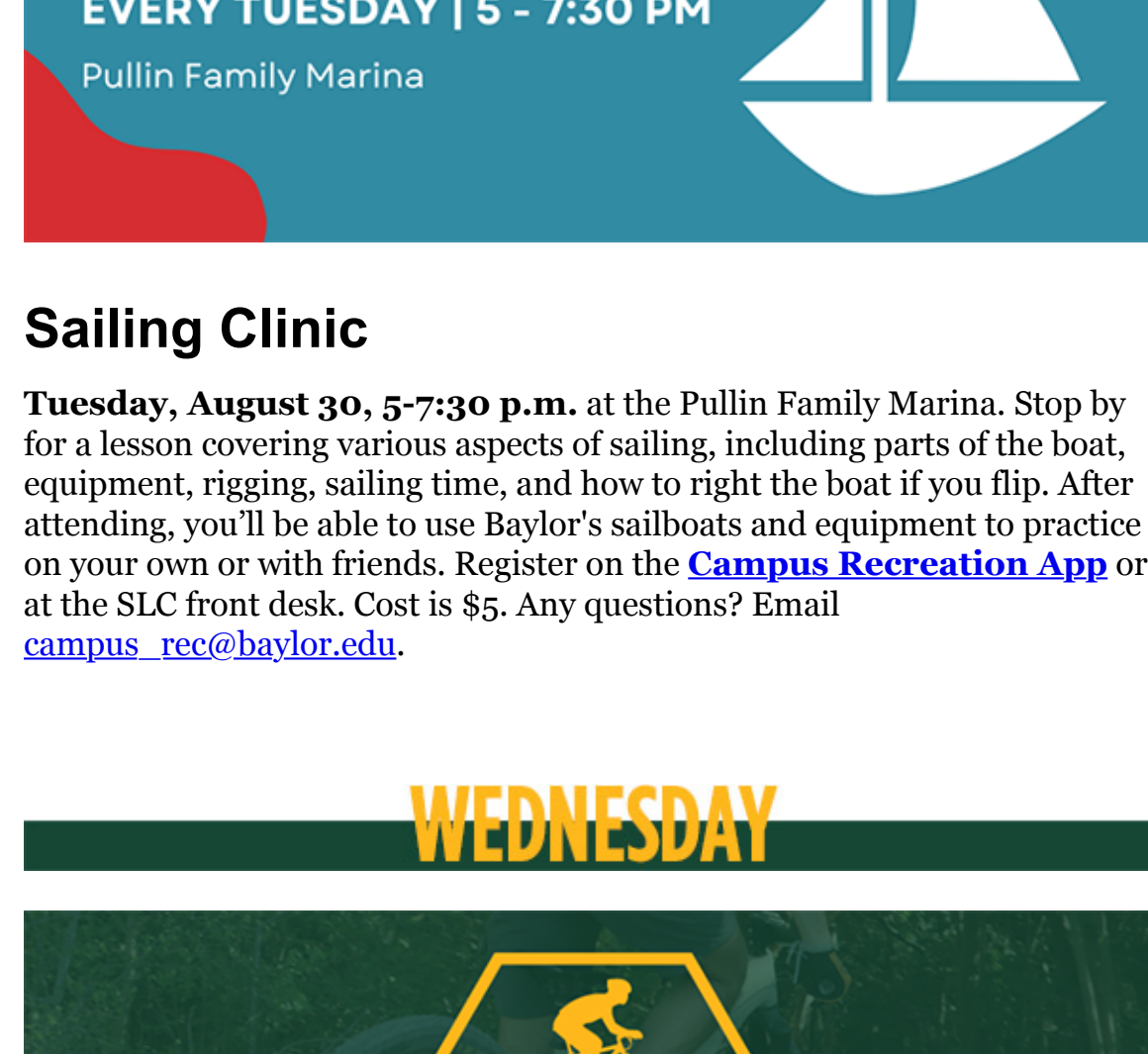

MOSAIC LatinX Night

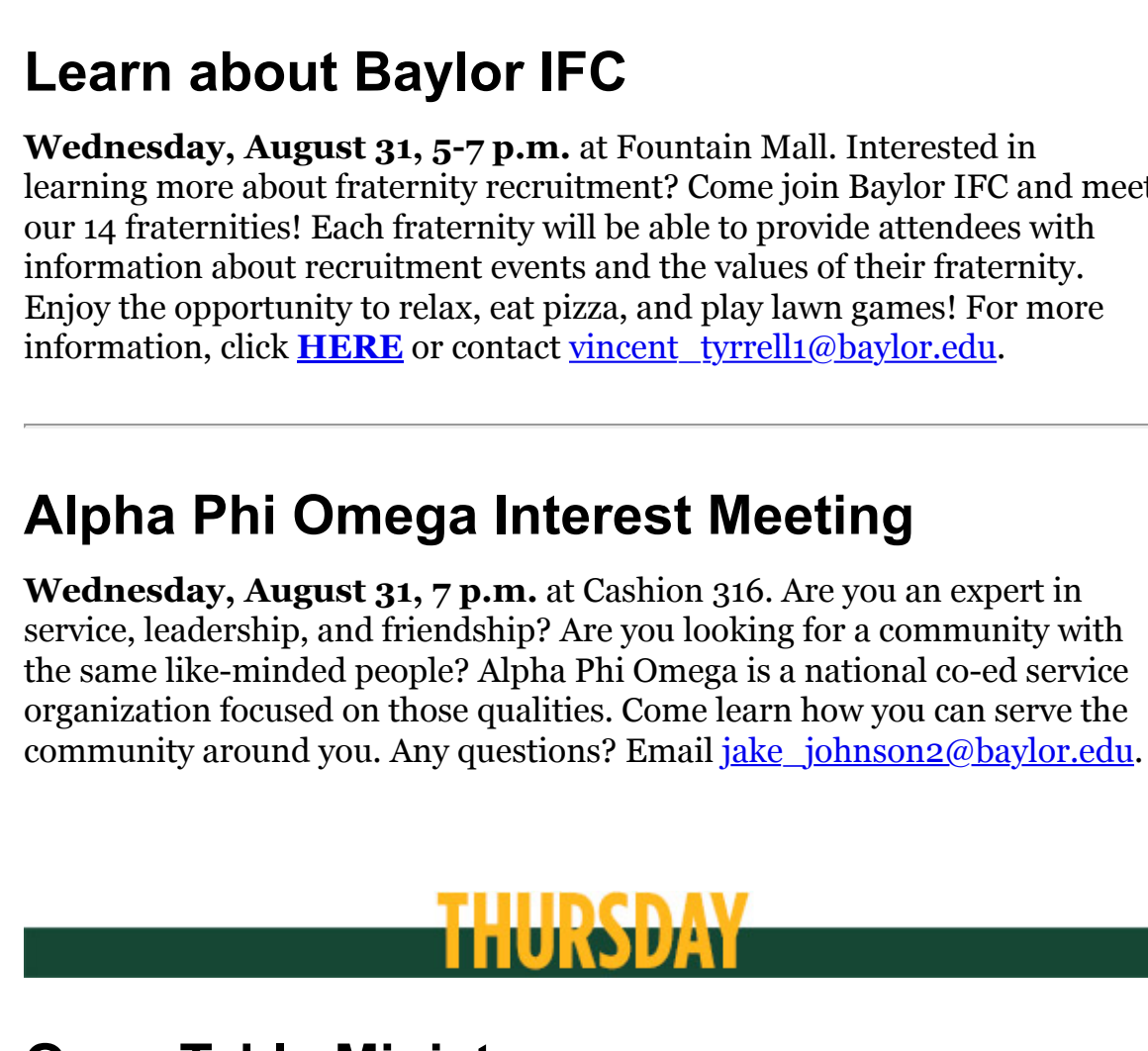

MOSAIC Asian Night

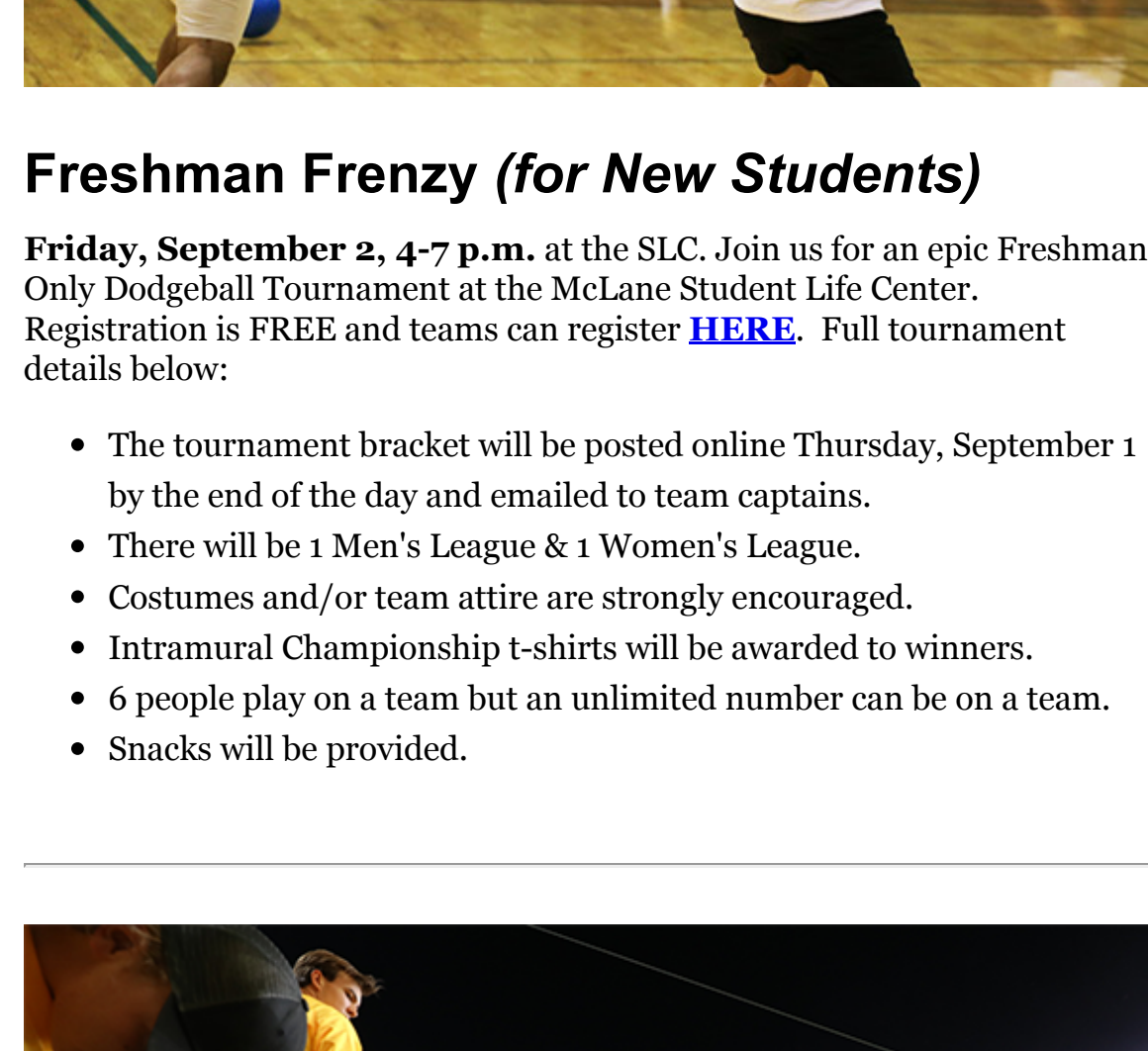

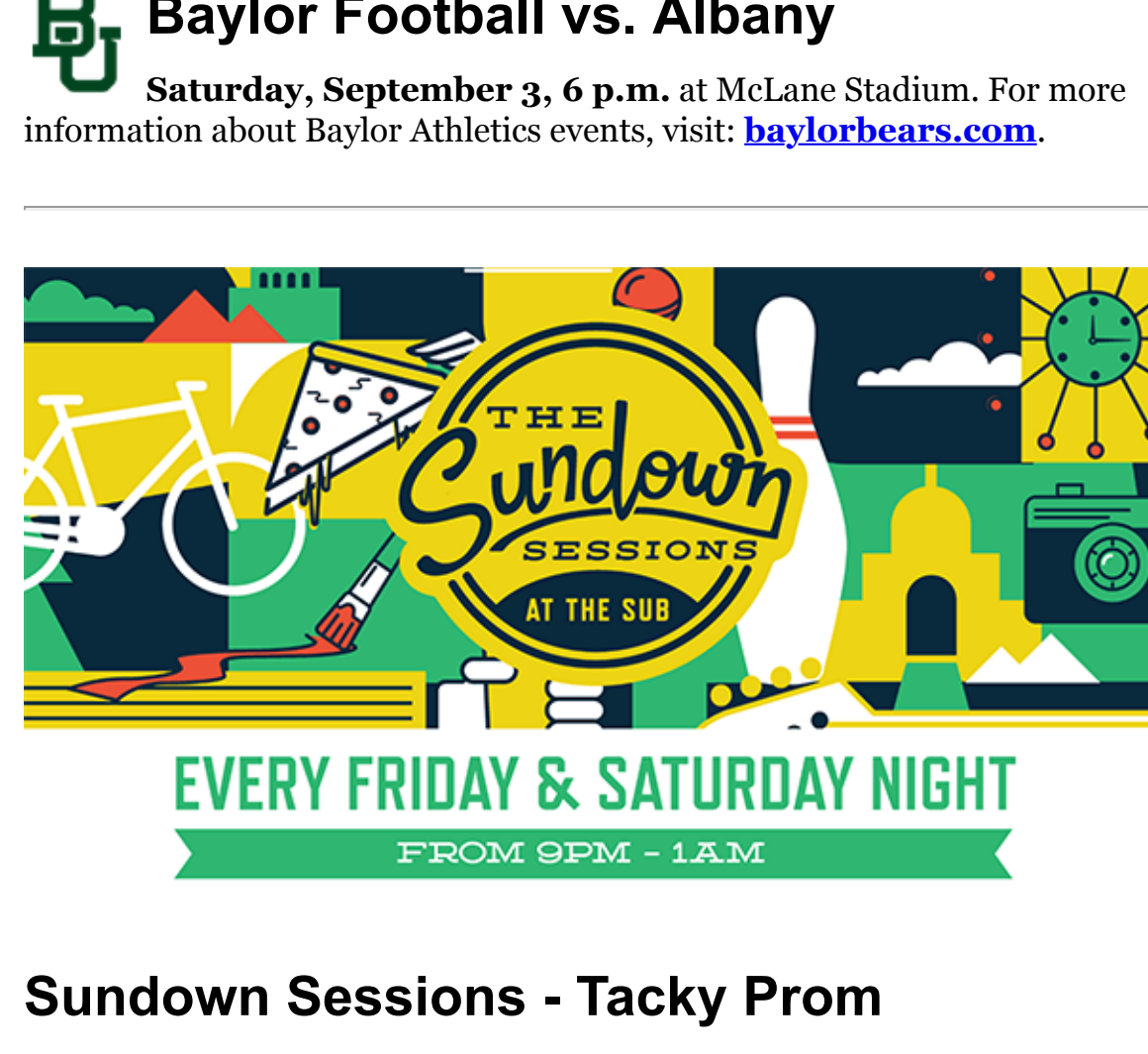
Open Table Ministry

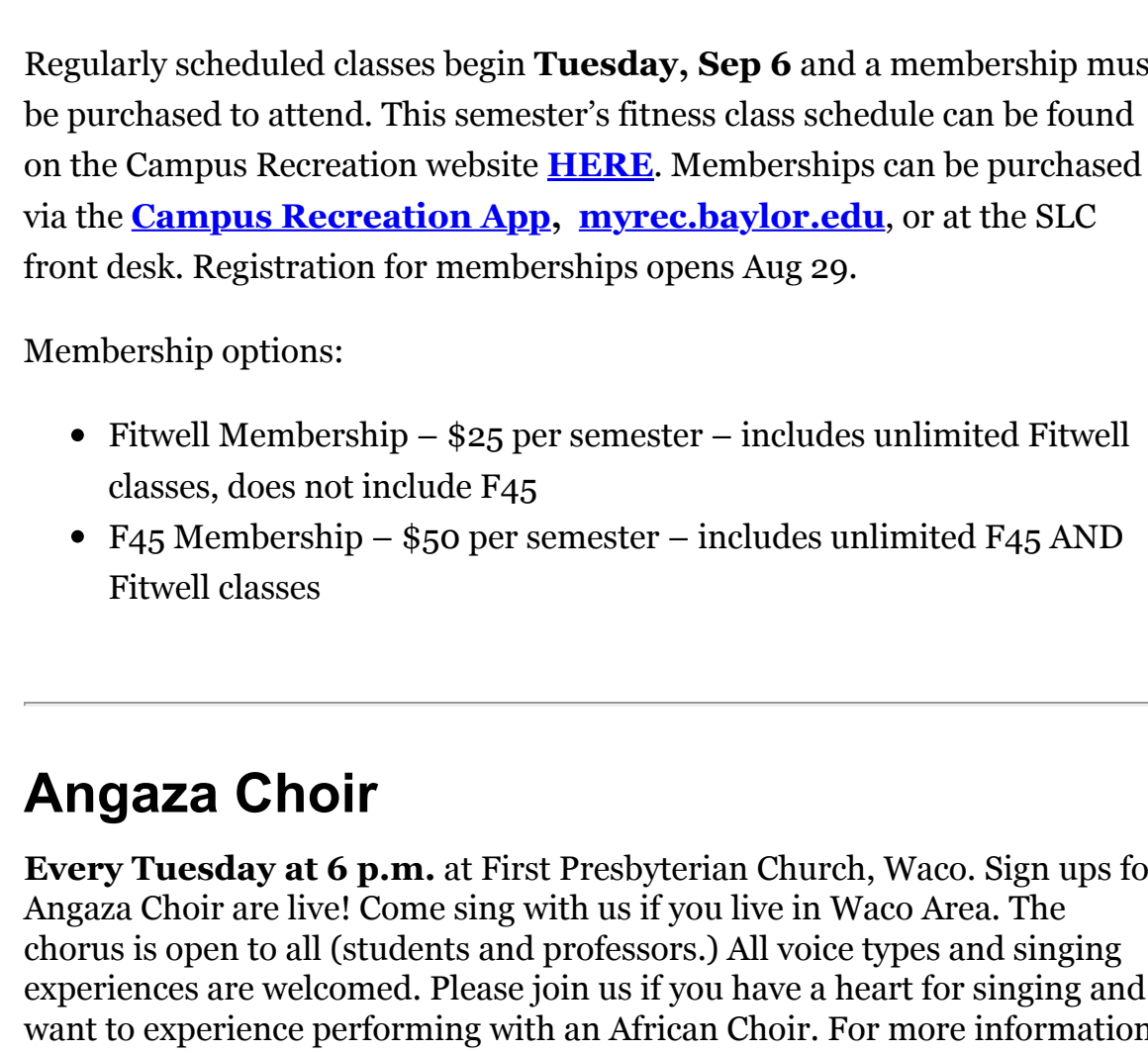

Freshman Frenzy (for New Students)

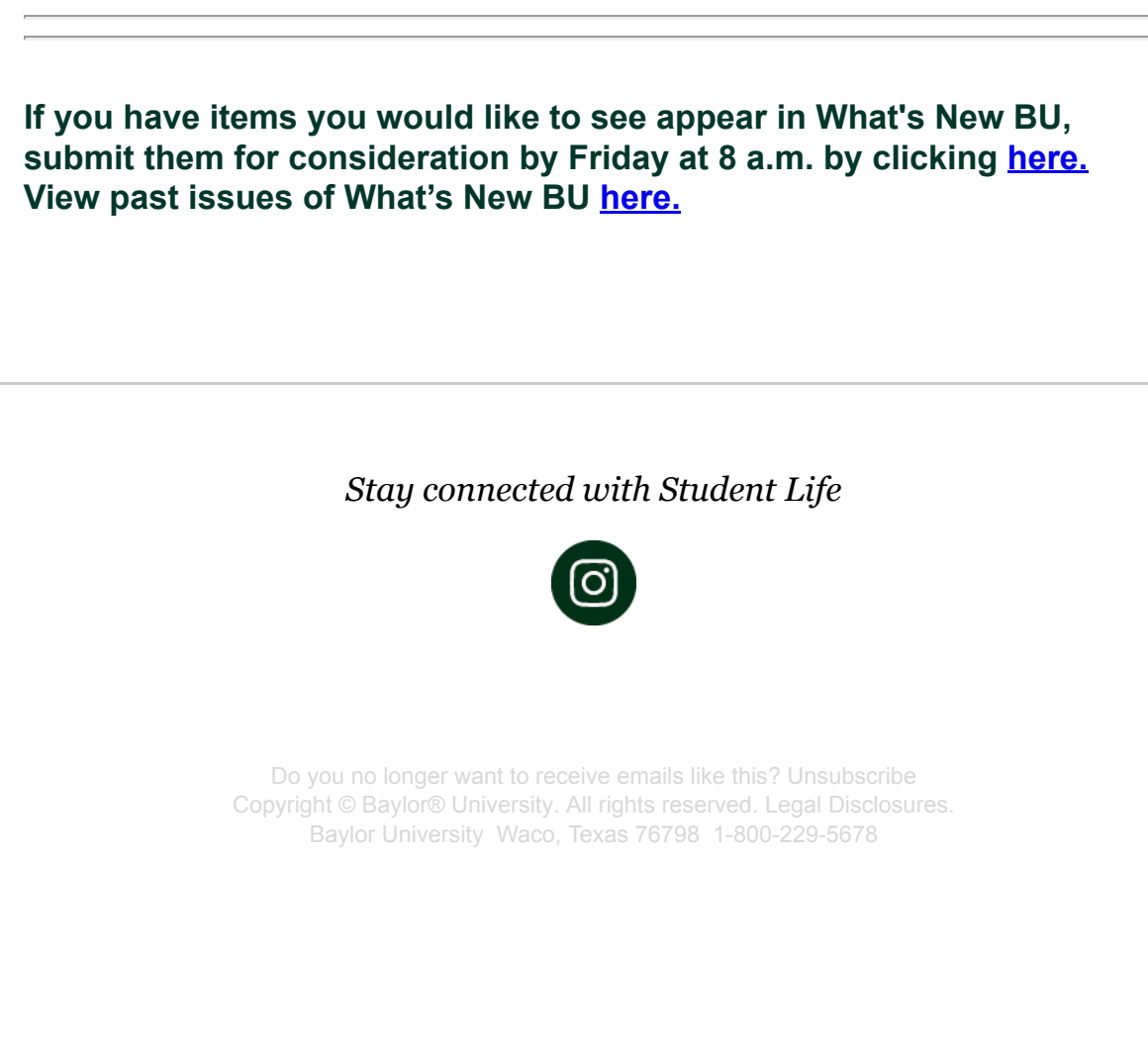
