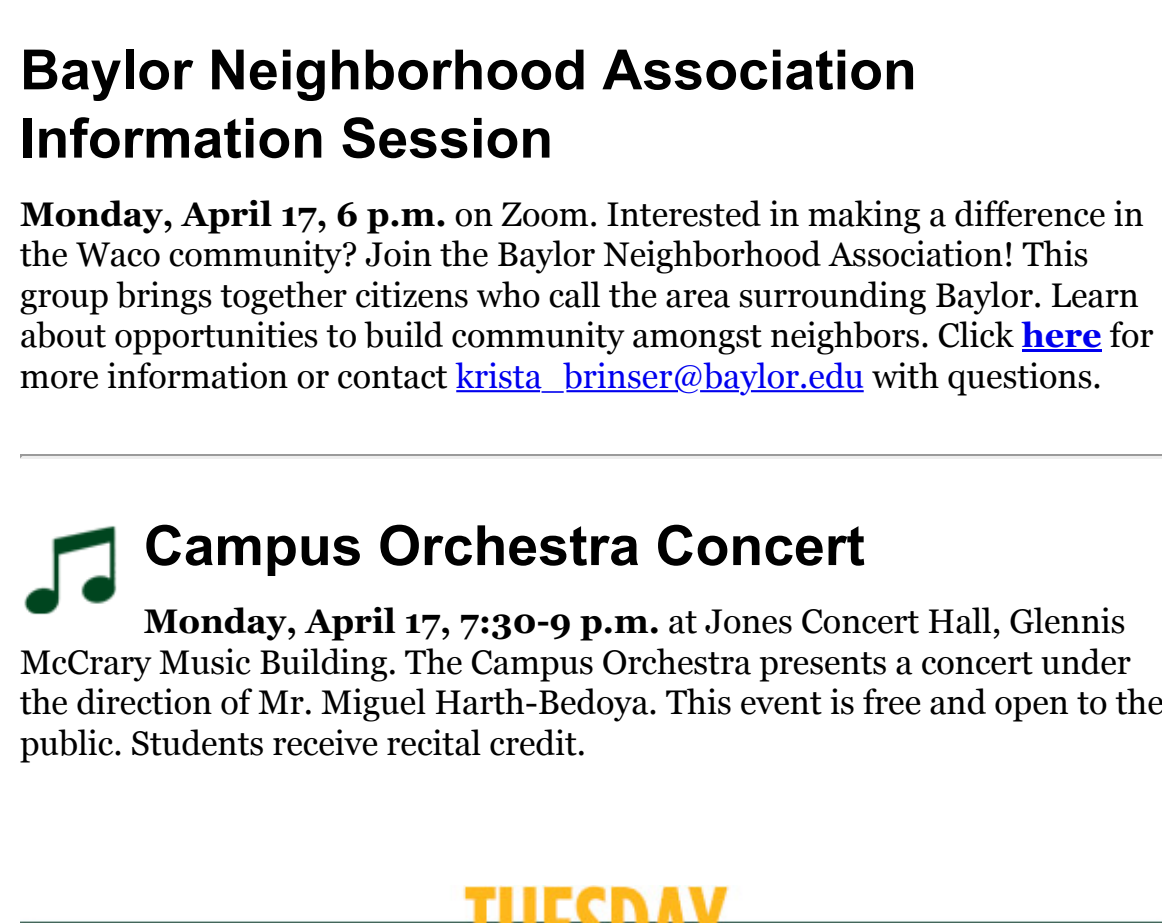

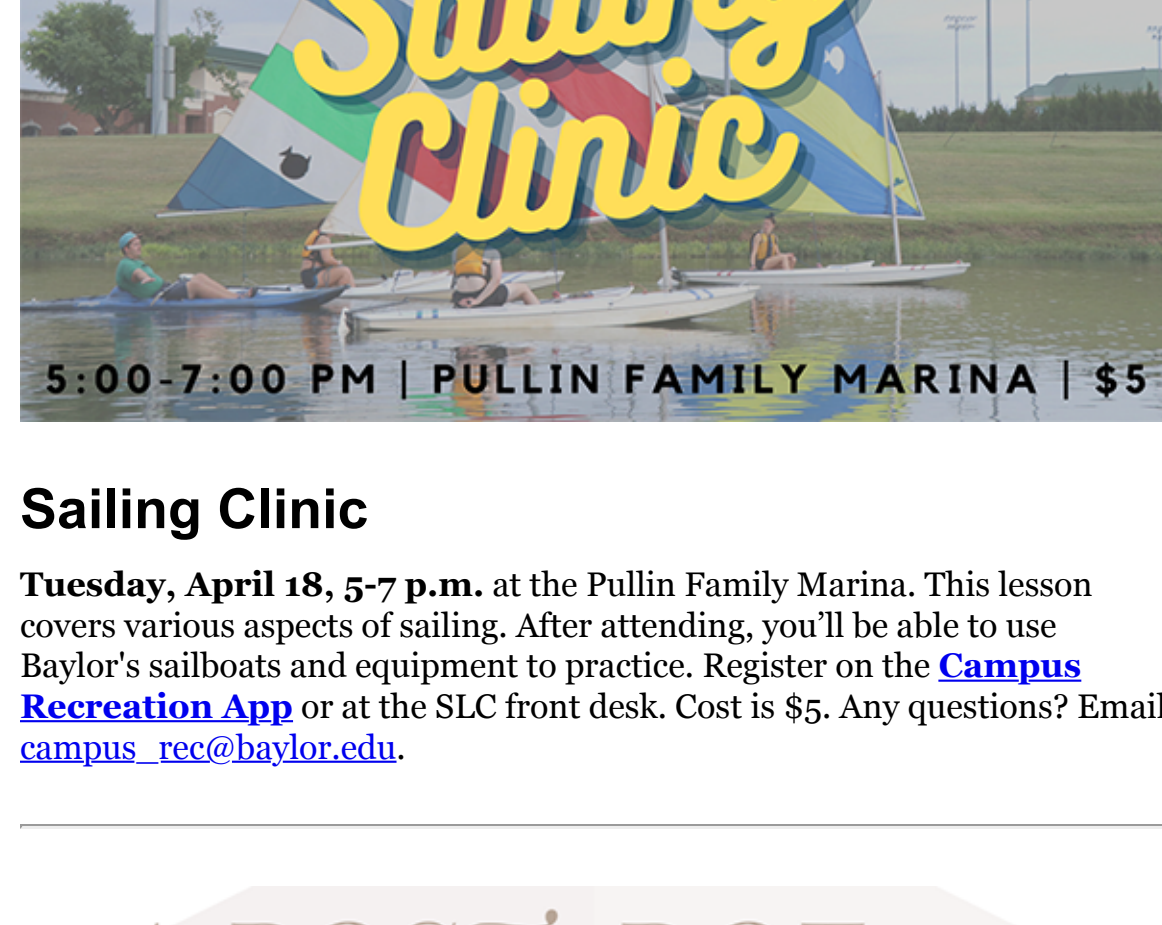
### Baylor Neighborhood Association Information Session

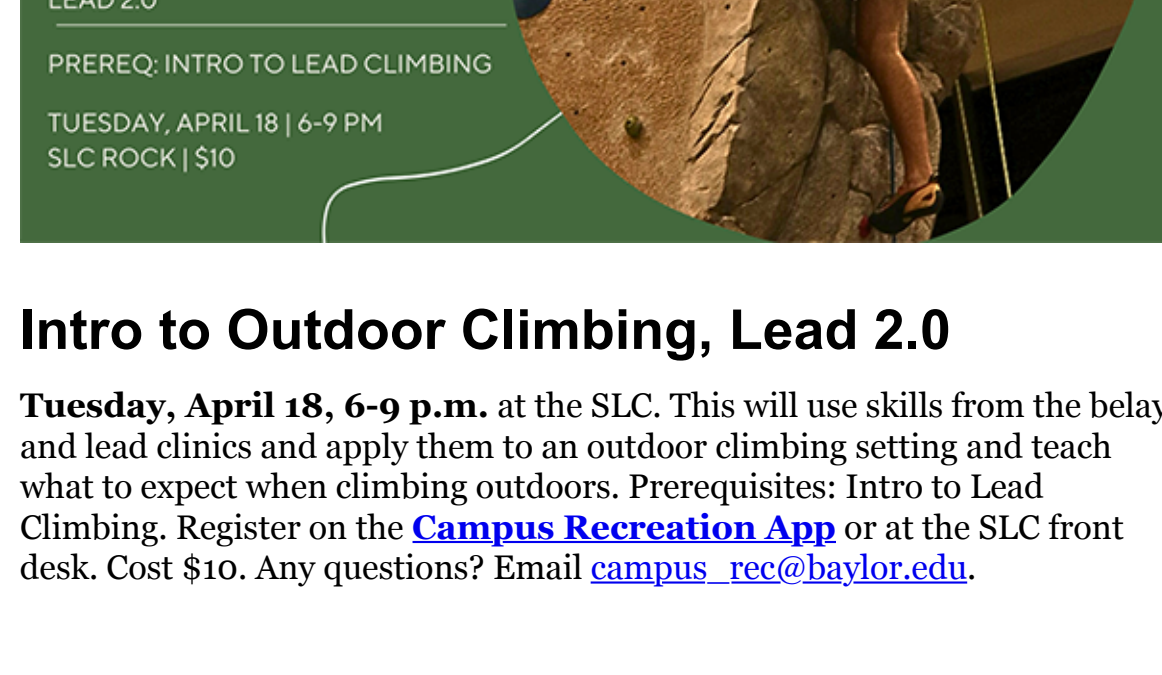


### Dr Pepper Hour

### A Post-Roe America Professor Panel

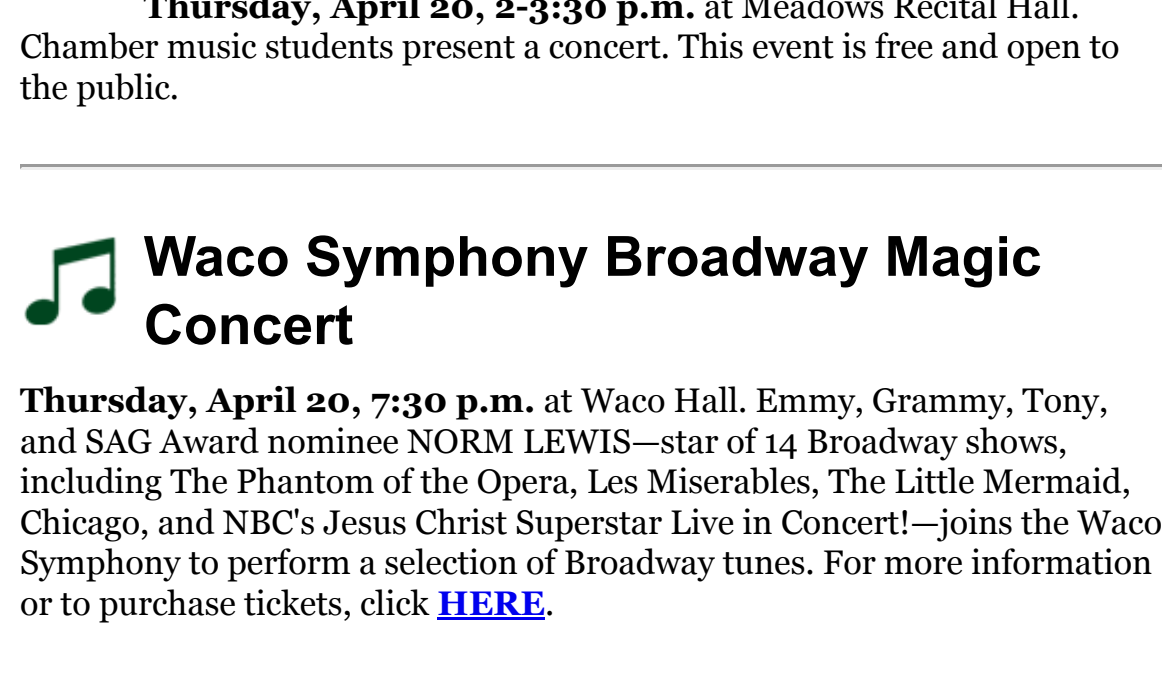

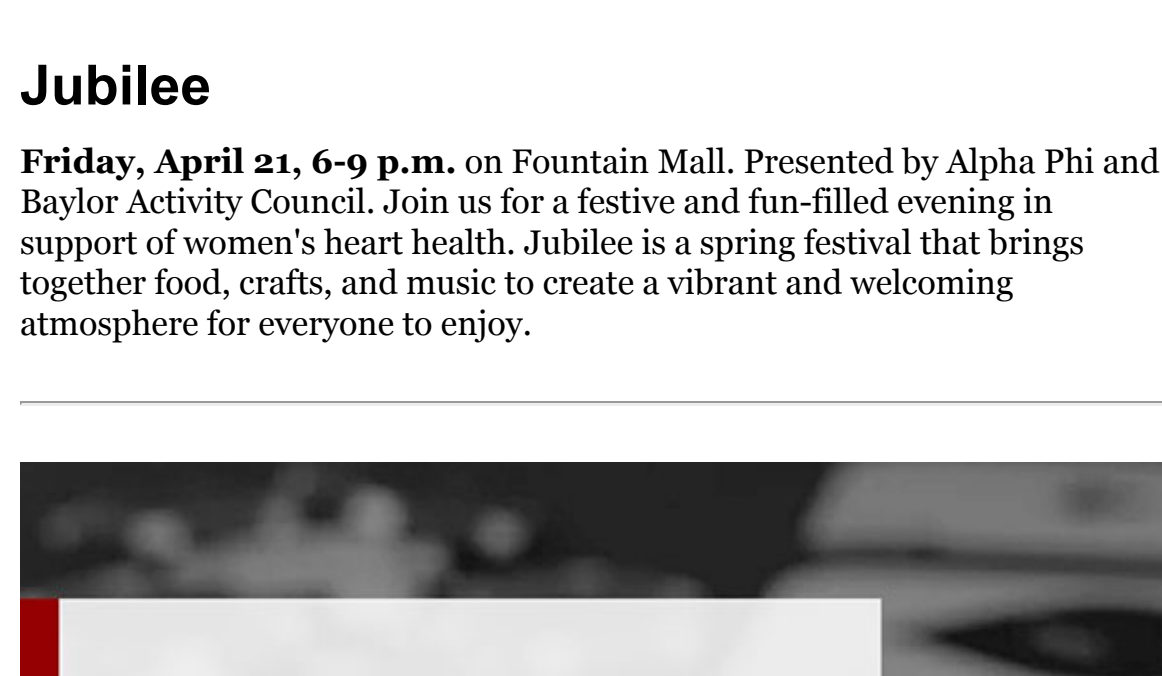


### Mountain Bike Clinic

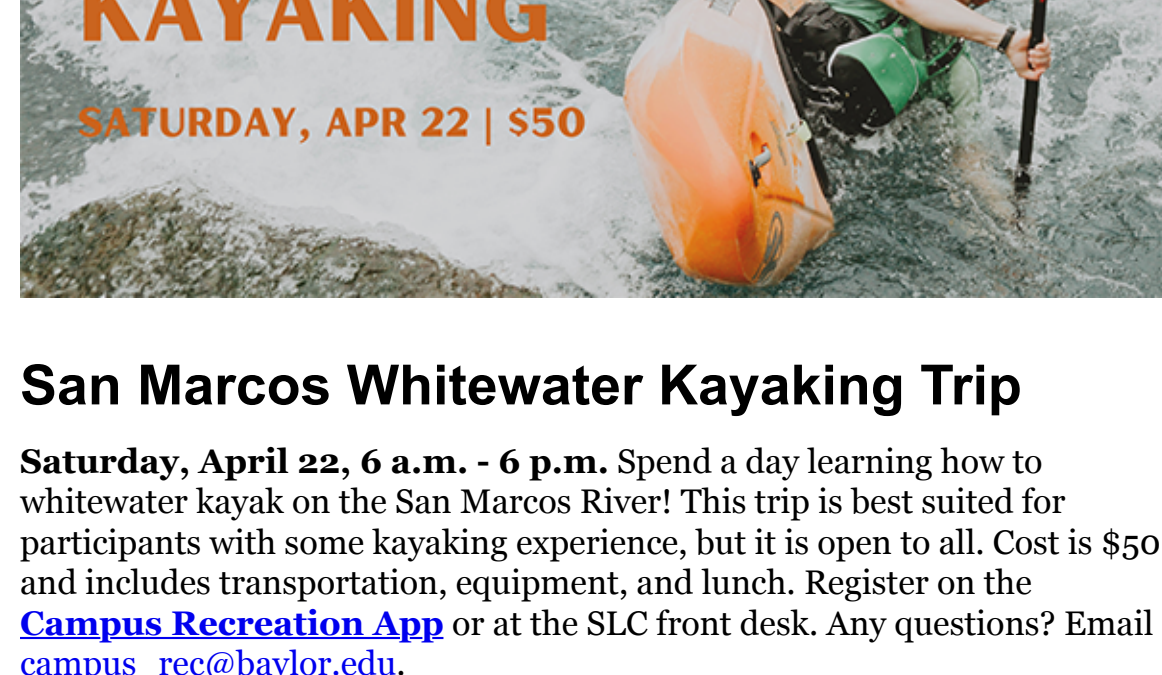

### Waco Symphony Broadway Magic Concert

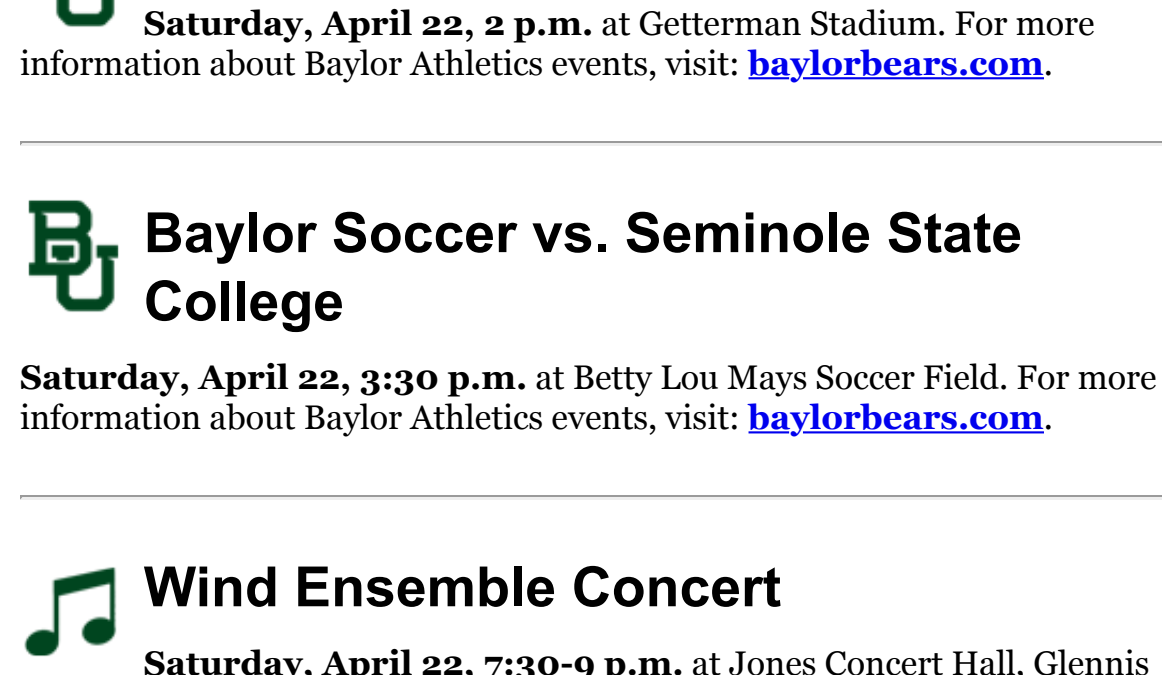
