










Dr Pepper Hour

Accepting HONOR COUNCIL Student Applications

The Honor Council is seeking qualified students to apply for the 2023-2024 year, with service beginning this summer. The Council has exclusive jurisdiction over all academic matters involving dishonorable conduct that are not resolved between the student and the faculty member in whose class the incident occurred. Each student member must have a current and cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher at the time of the appointment and must maintain a current and cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher during service.

The Honor Council is crucial to the Academic Integrity process at Baylor. If you are interested in serving, have the qualifications indicated above, and are willing to commit an average of two hours per week (usually around 3:30 in the afternoon), please complete the application found <u>HERE</u>.
