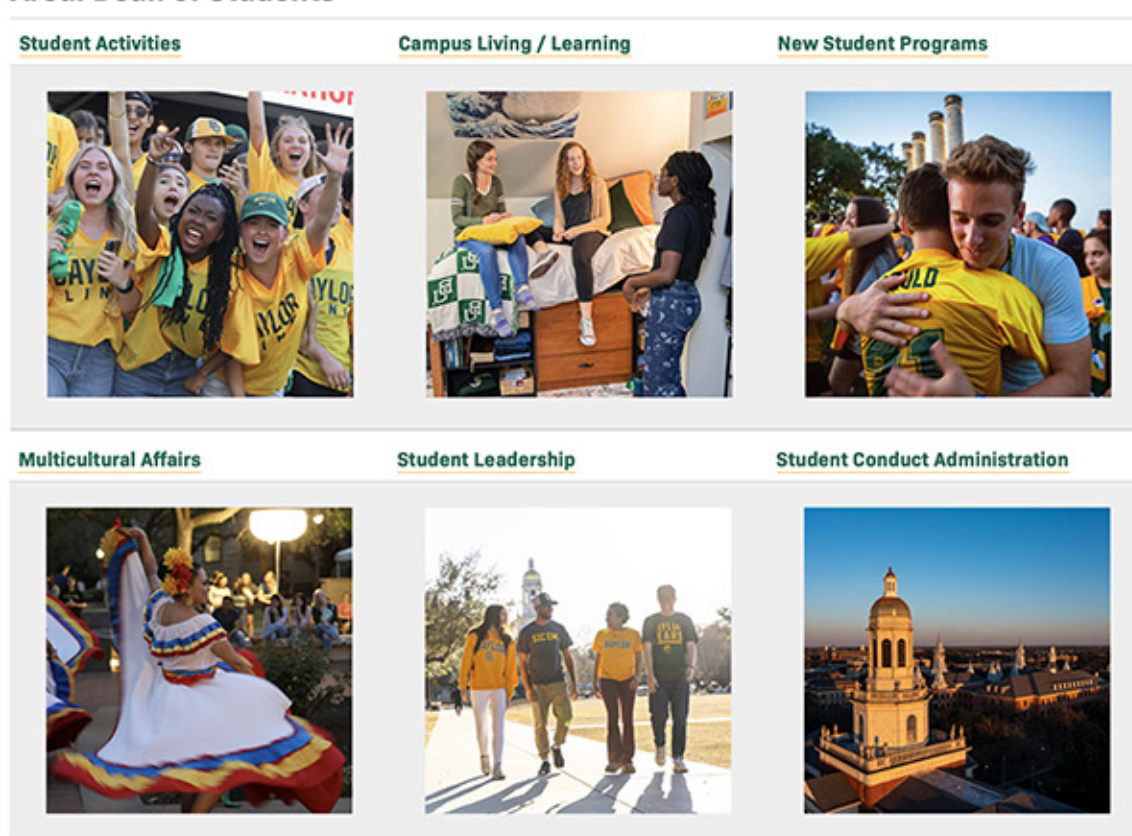
Dear Divisional Colleagues,

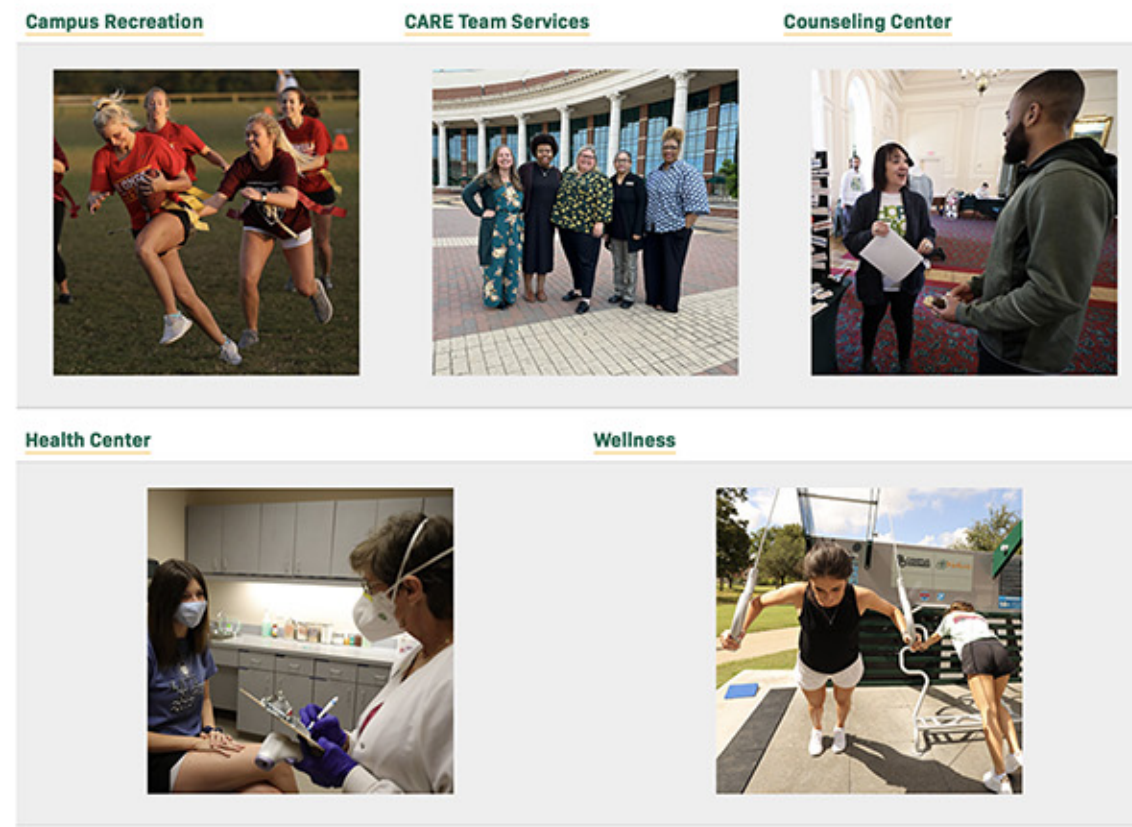
End of Year Report

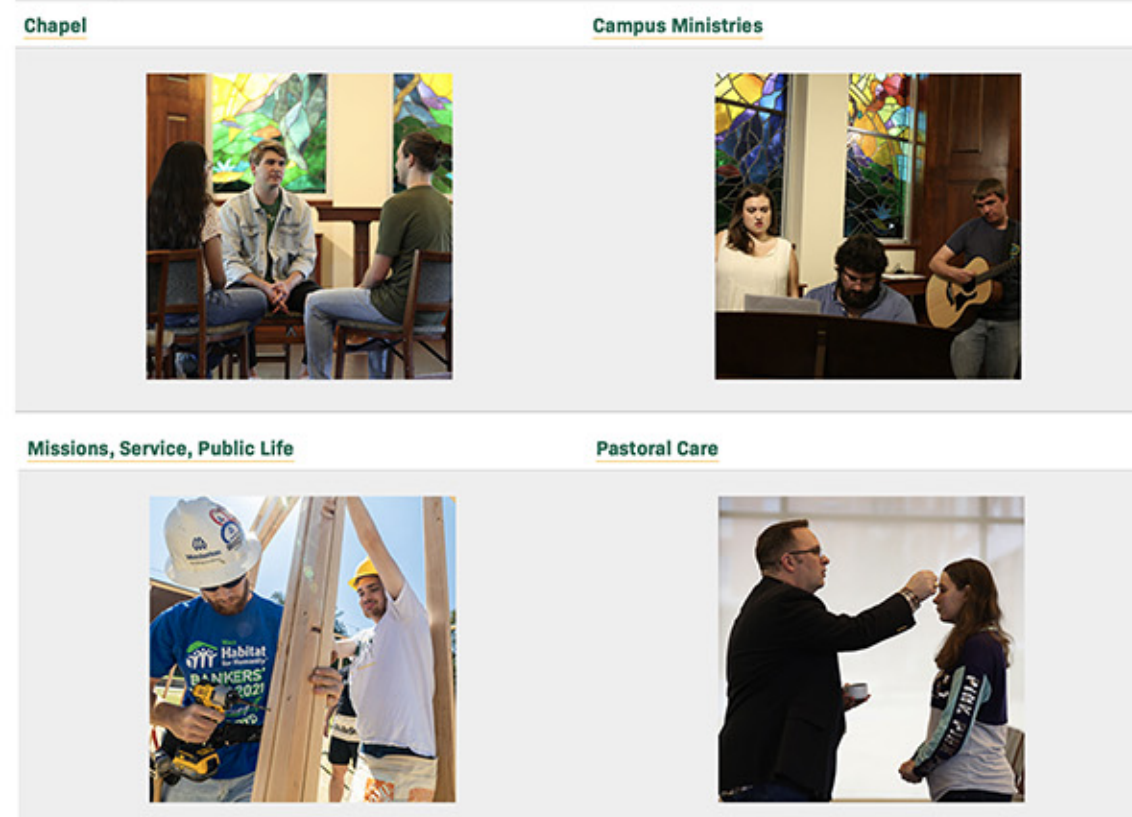
