

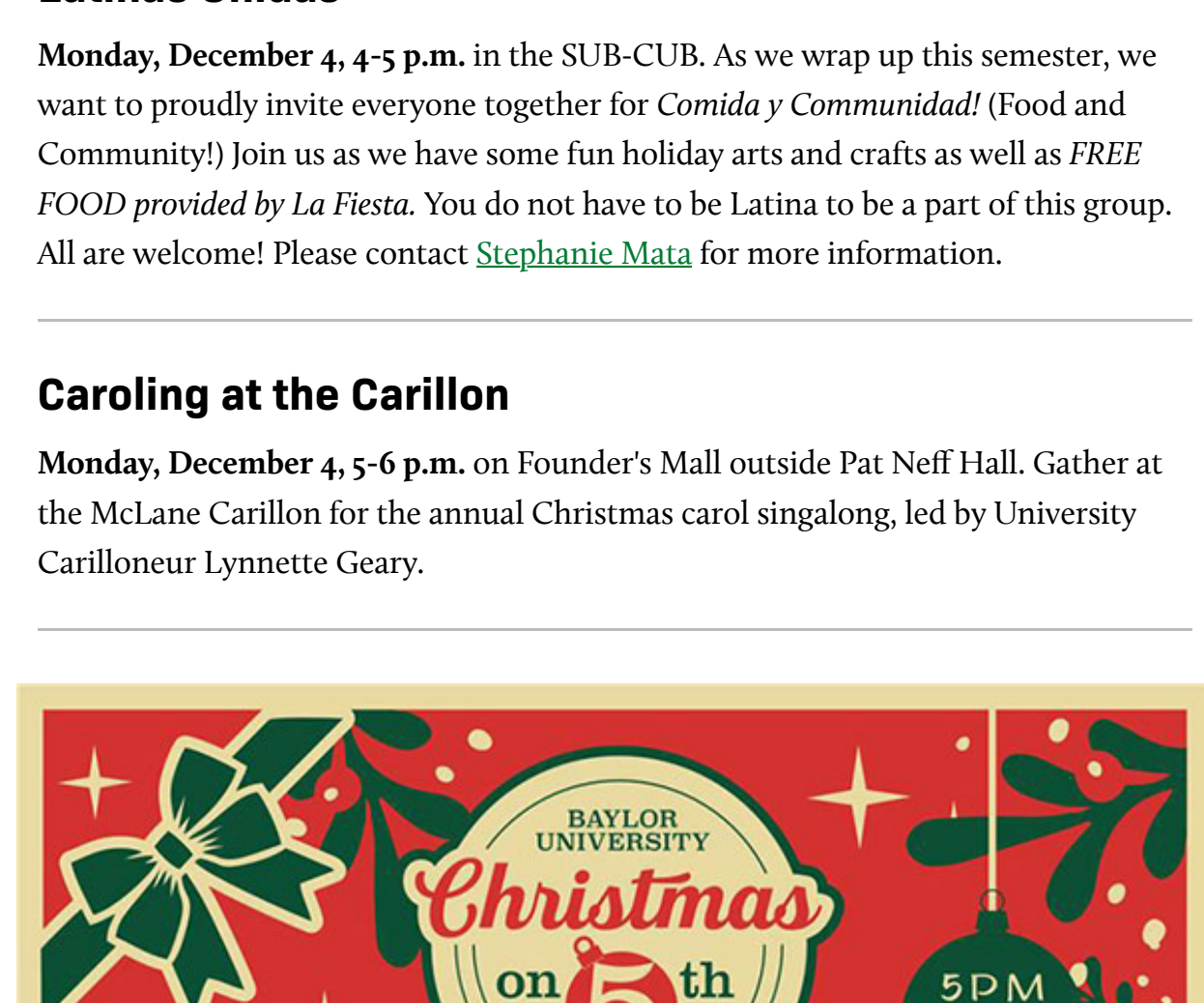

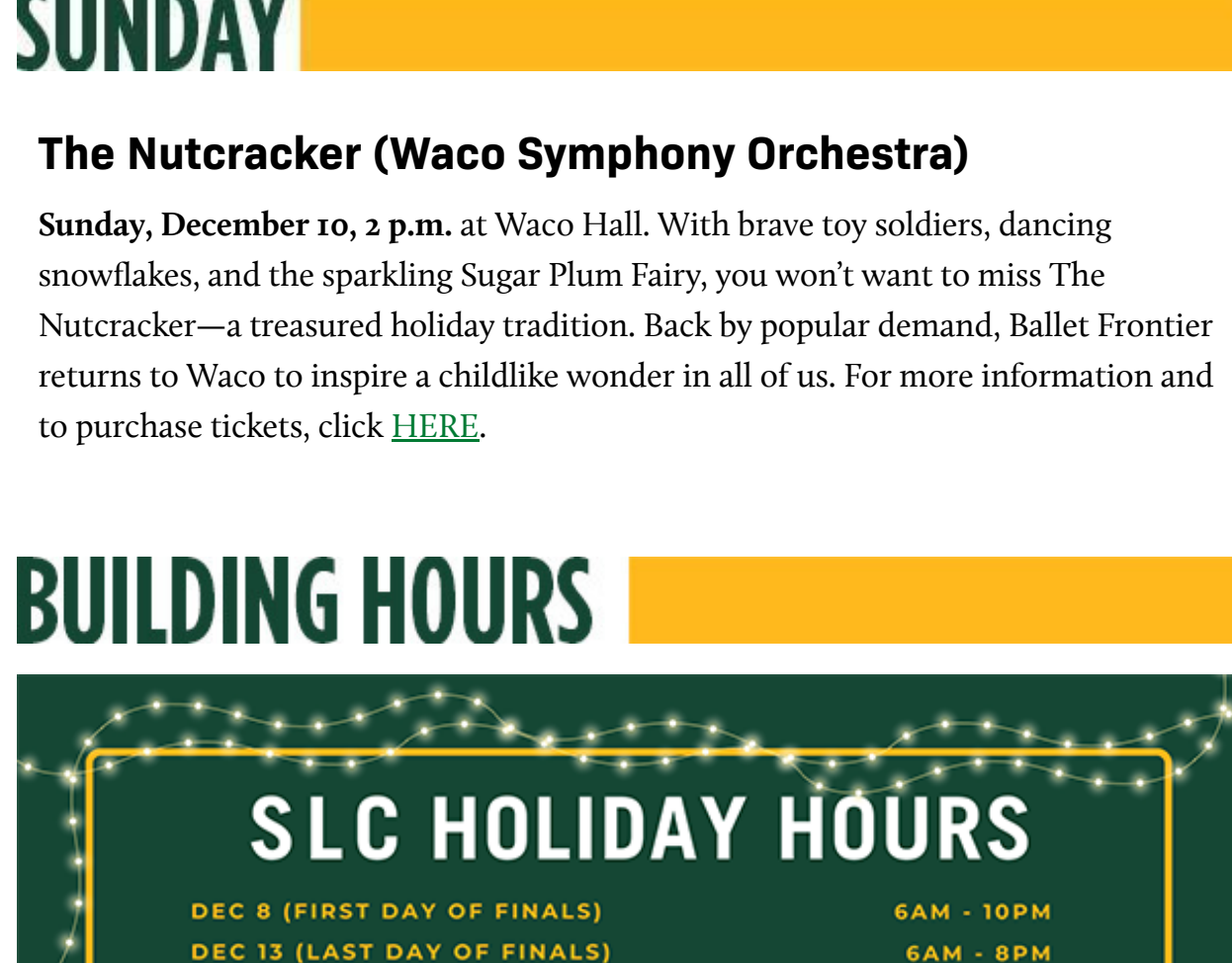

Breakfast Tacos with the First Gent

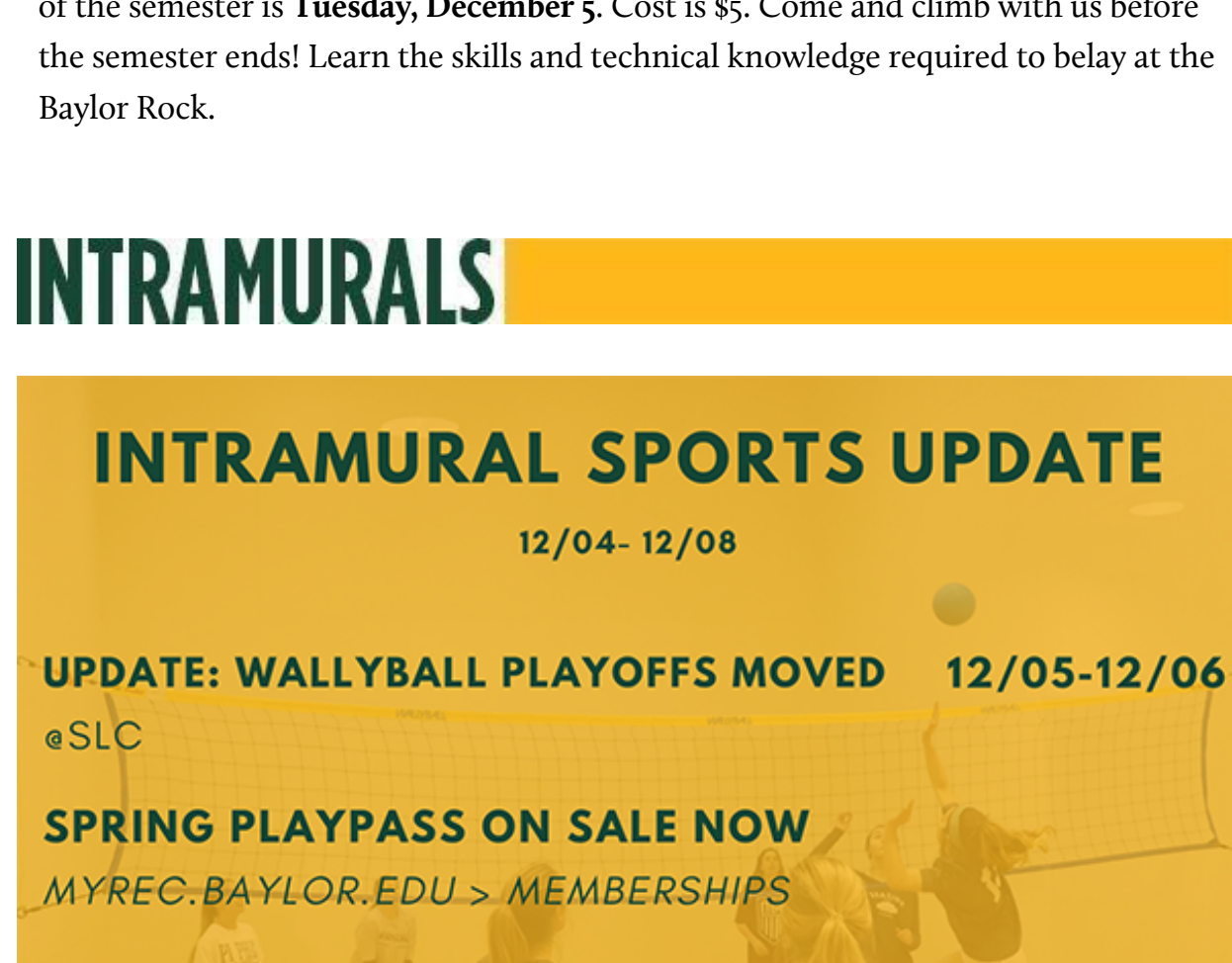

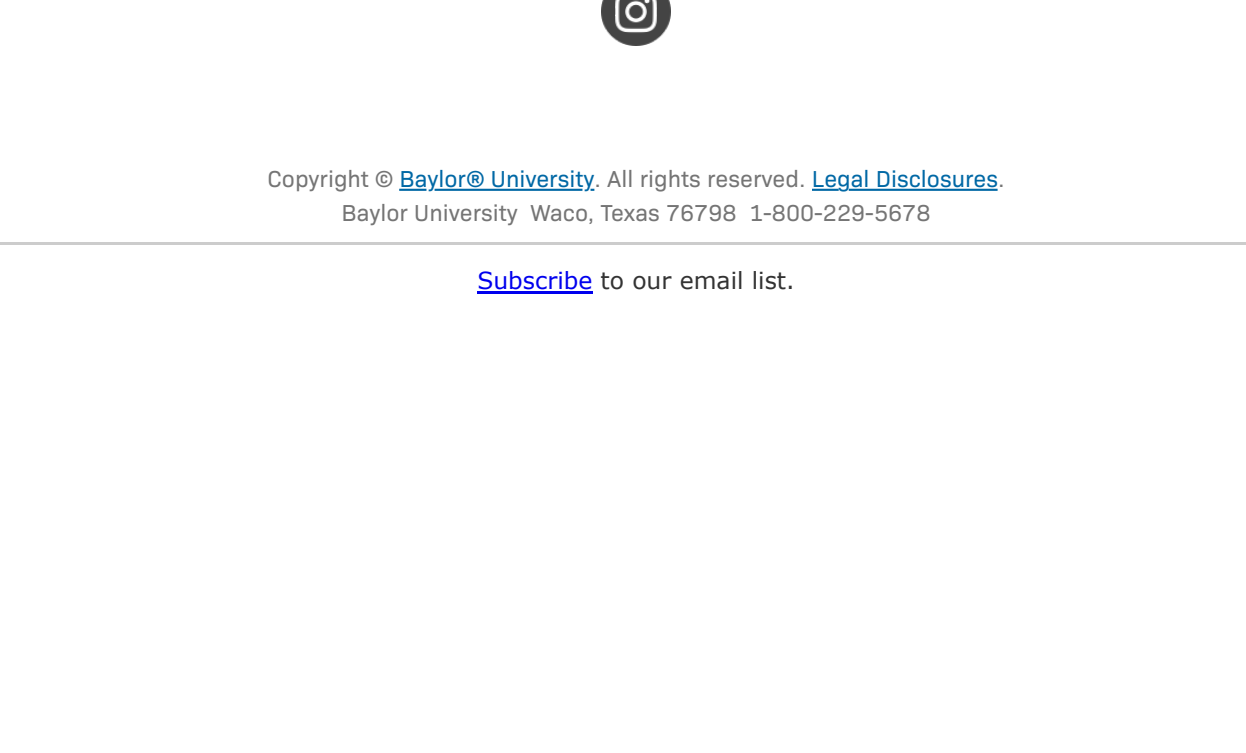


Happening in Intramurals...
