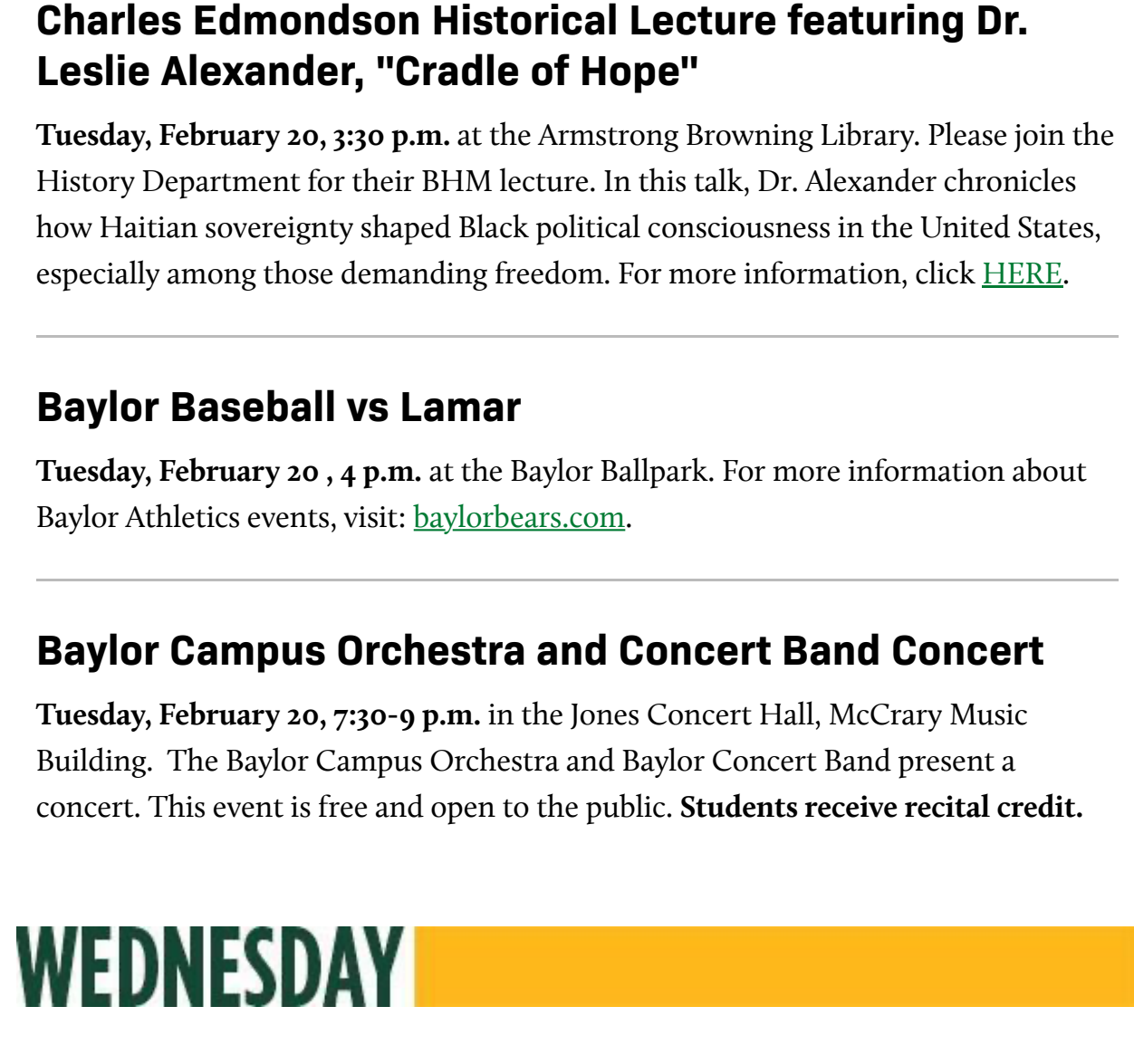

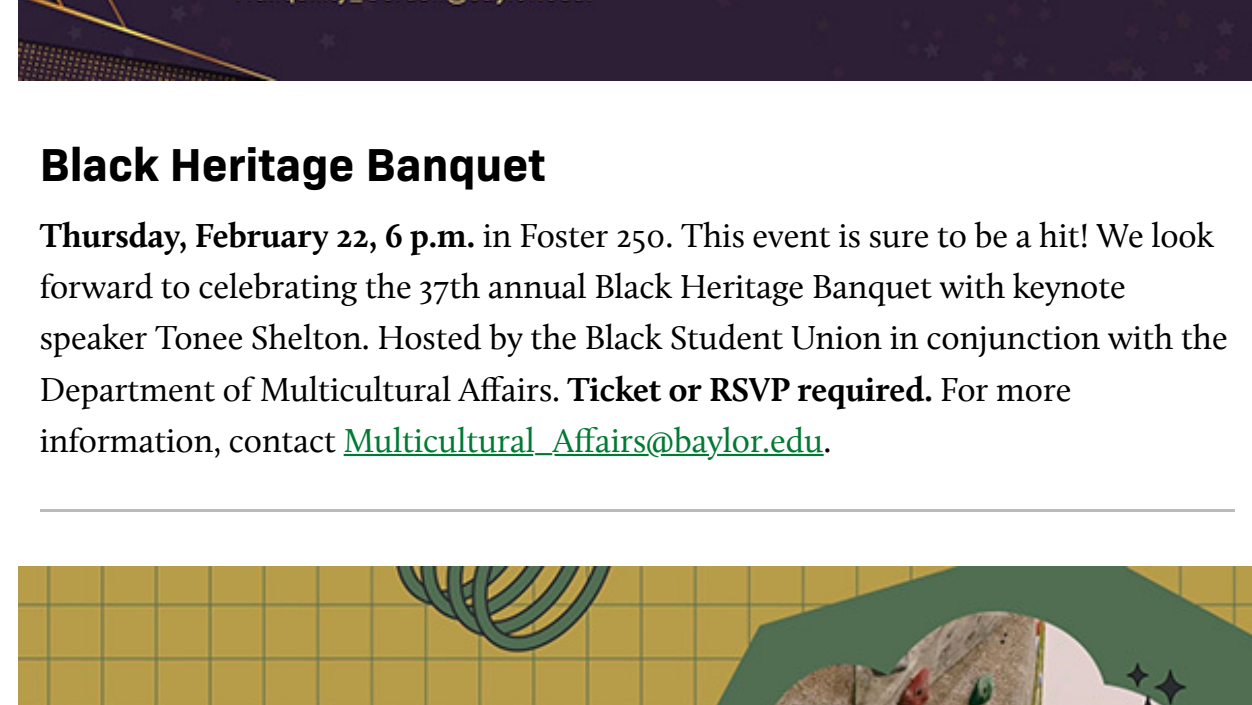

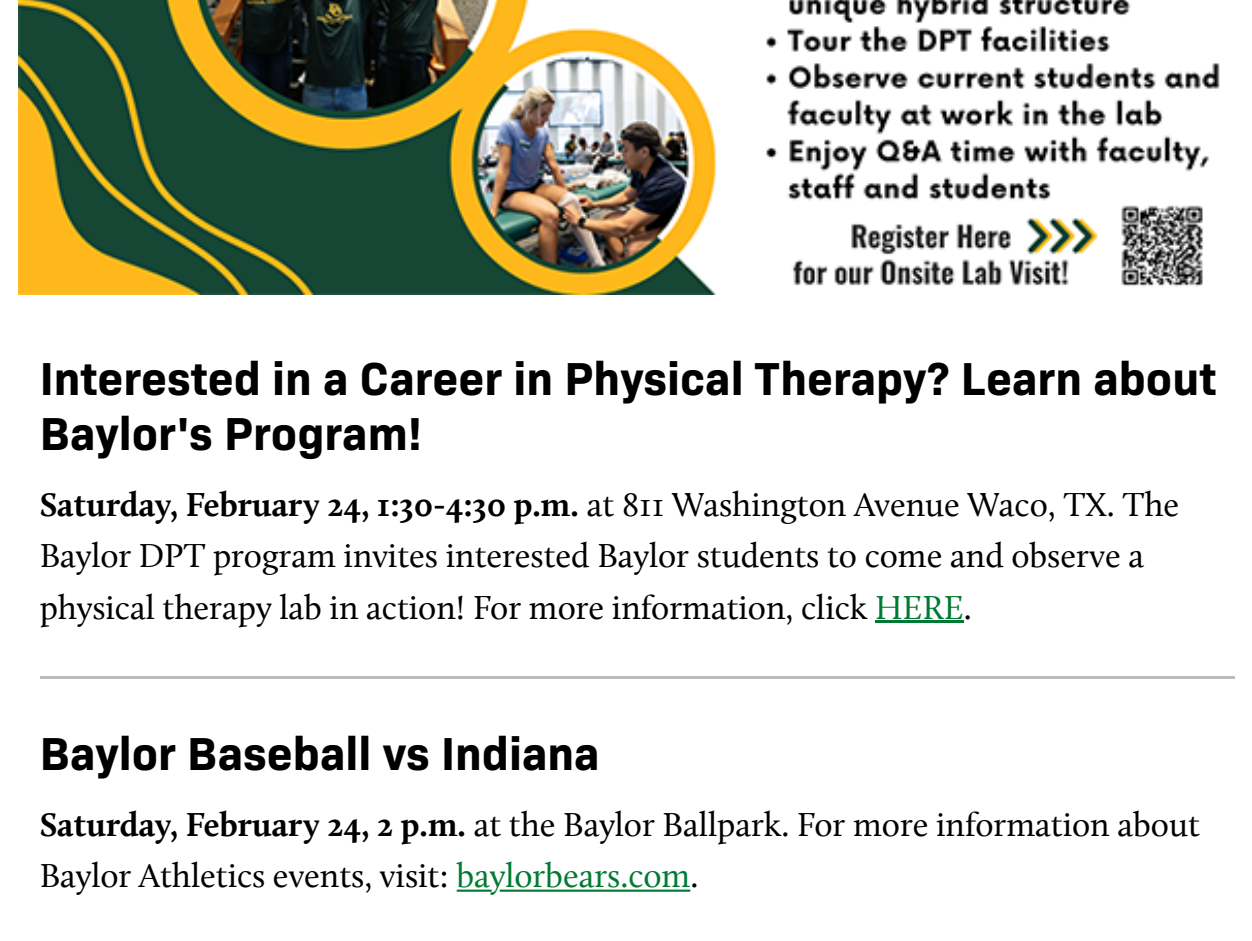

Intro to Lead Climbing

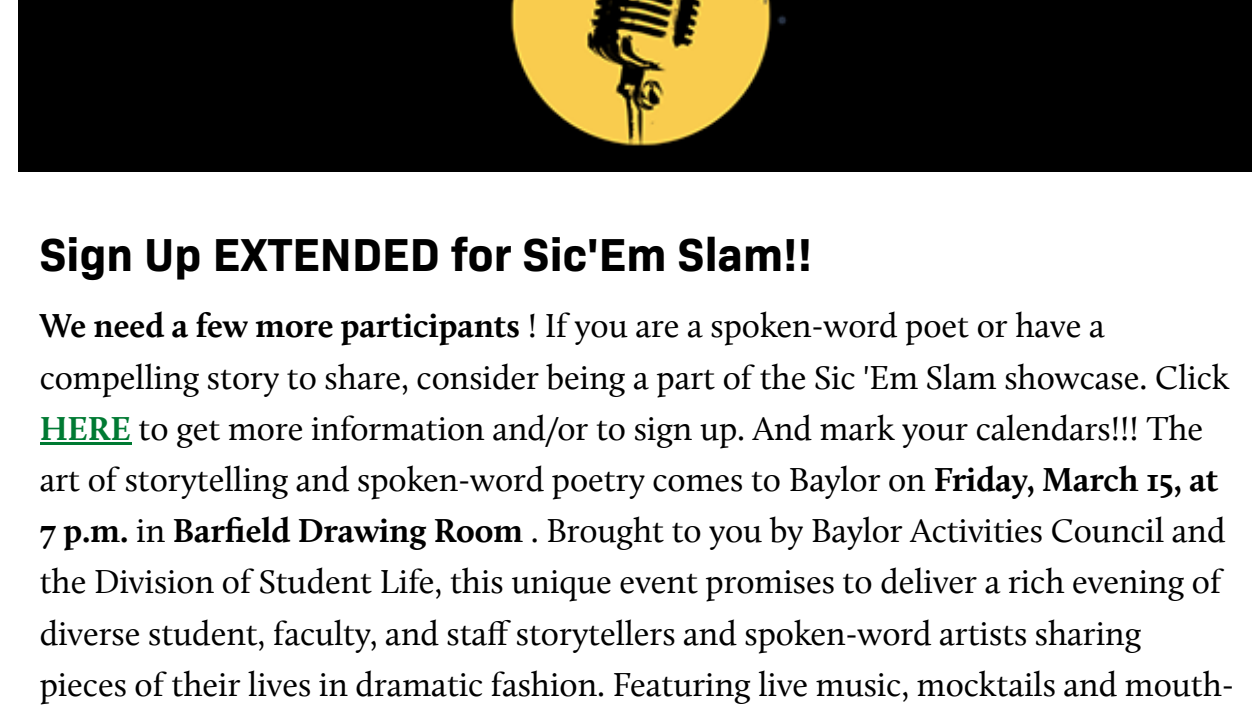

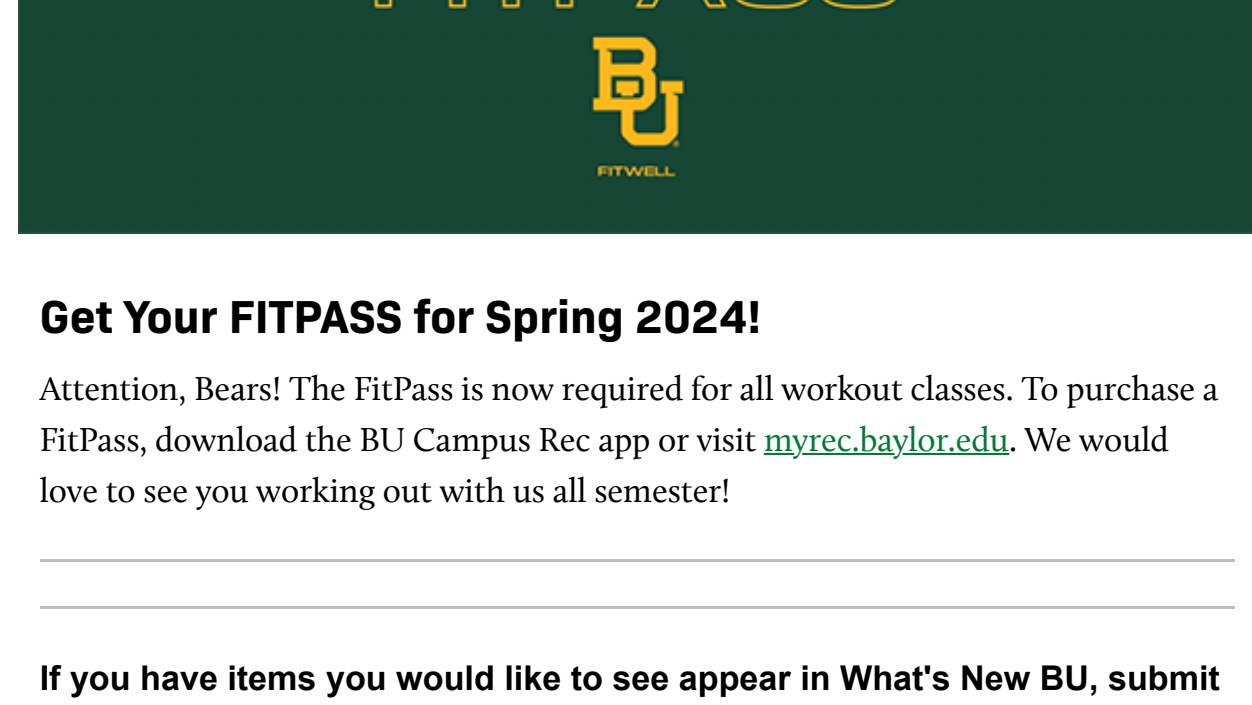
