SL End-of-Year Celebration – May 2 - Last Thursday we came together as a Division to celebrate this past year and all of its accomplishments. **Nearly 200 Student Life staff and campus partners gathered to share food and fellowship.** We also were joined by members of the Board of Regents including the Chair of the Student Life Committee, Melissa Mines, who shared remarks and gratitude for the Division. ESLAC – May 2 – The *Excellence in Student Leadership Awards* recognize the outstanding contributions made by student leaders, student employees, and faculty/staff advisors across campus and in the community. Departments throughout the Division of Student Life, in conjunction with Student Government, recognized nominees for their significant leadership and service in a variety of capacities within their respective organizations, across campus, and beyond. This year, roughly 400 people attended as we honored students, faculty, and staff, and celebrated their contributions to Baylor Student Life.

Most enjoyable about working at Baylor: "Everyone I've met here has been so welcoming and helpful. You can really tell that everyone here loves what they do."


SHOUTOUT
