While CL&L successfully assisted more than 4,000 students moving out this month, they also coordinated donations of more than 144 pallets, weighing **23,884 pounds** (literally 12 tons) in total donations to Caritas Waco. In addition, there was an RHA-led drive where a total of 2,500 pounds of non-perishable food items were collected and donated to the Store. Lastly, <u>Environmental Health & Safety</u> picked up nearly 500 items (mostly laundry and cleaning supplies) this semester, three times more than was collected in previous years!
