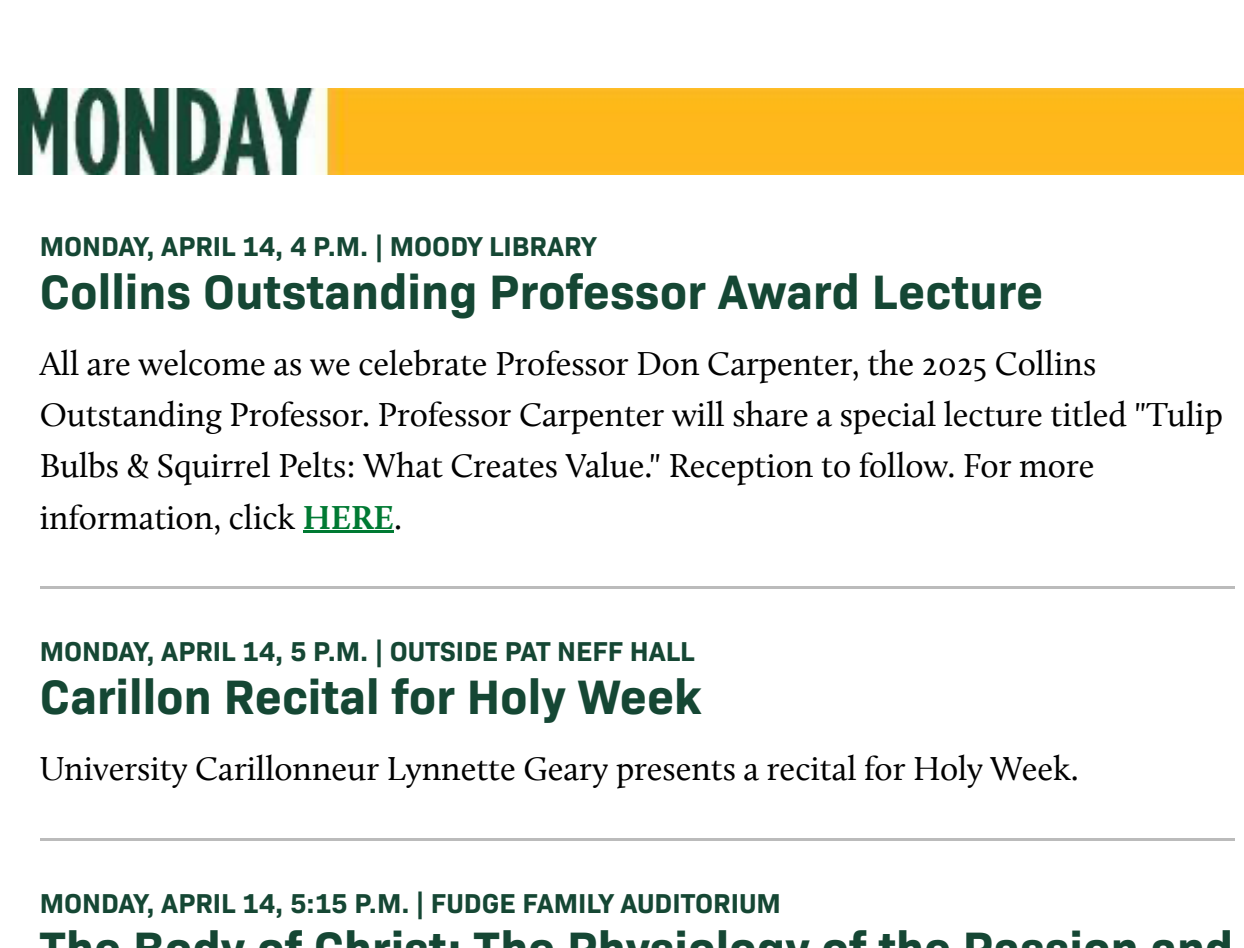

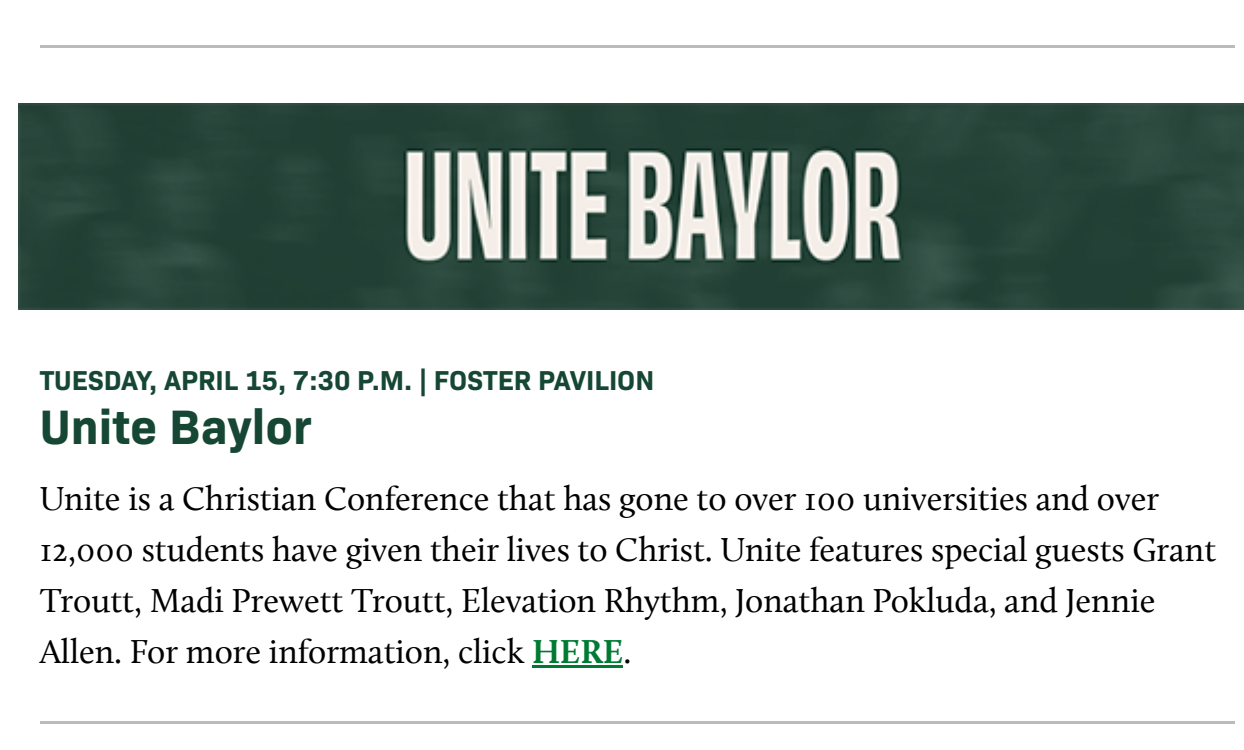
Baylor Libraries Author Series: Revelations of Divine Care

Dr Pepper Hour

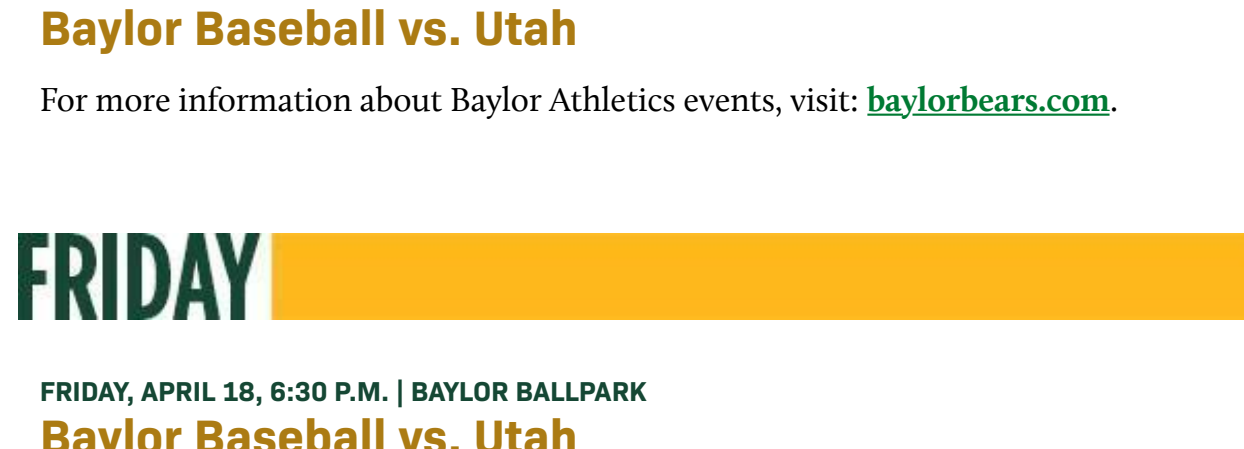

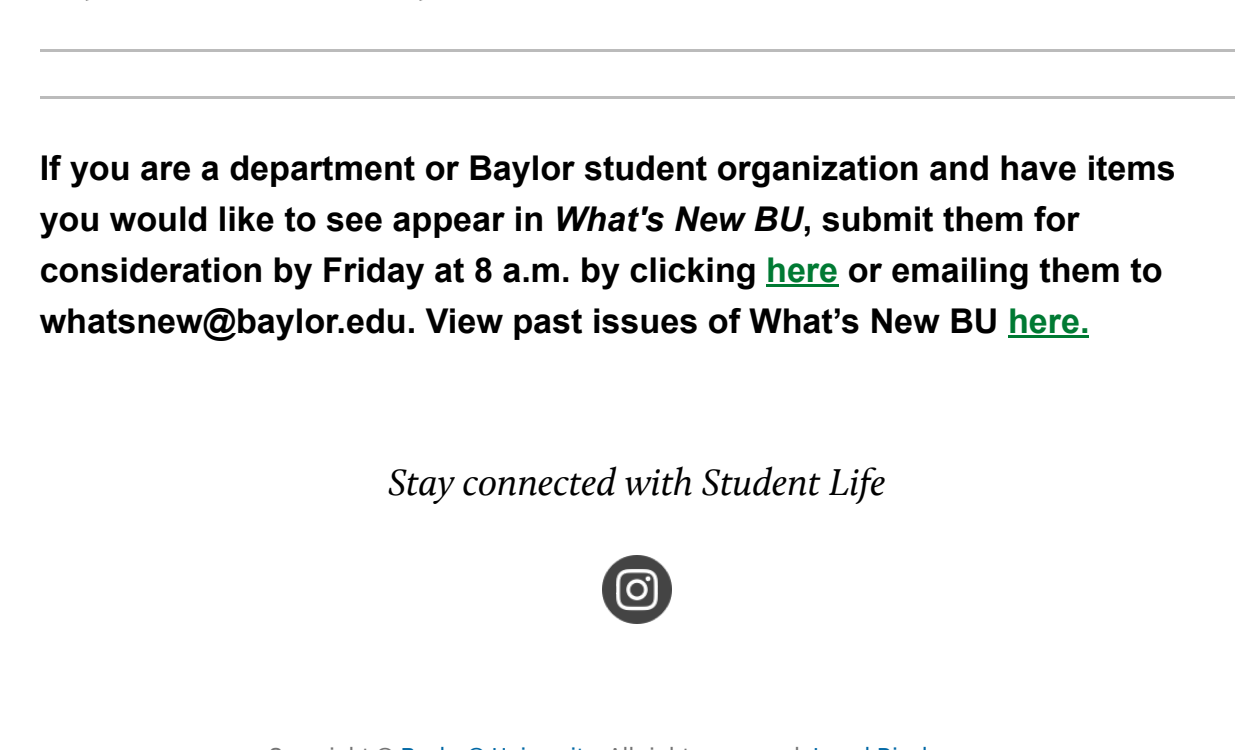
Mission Trip Commissioning
