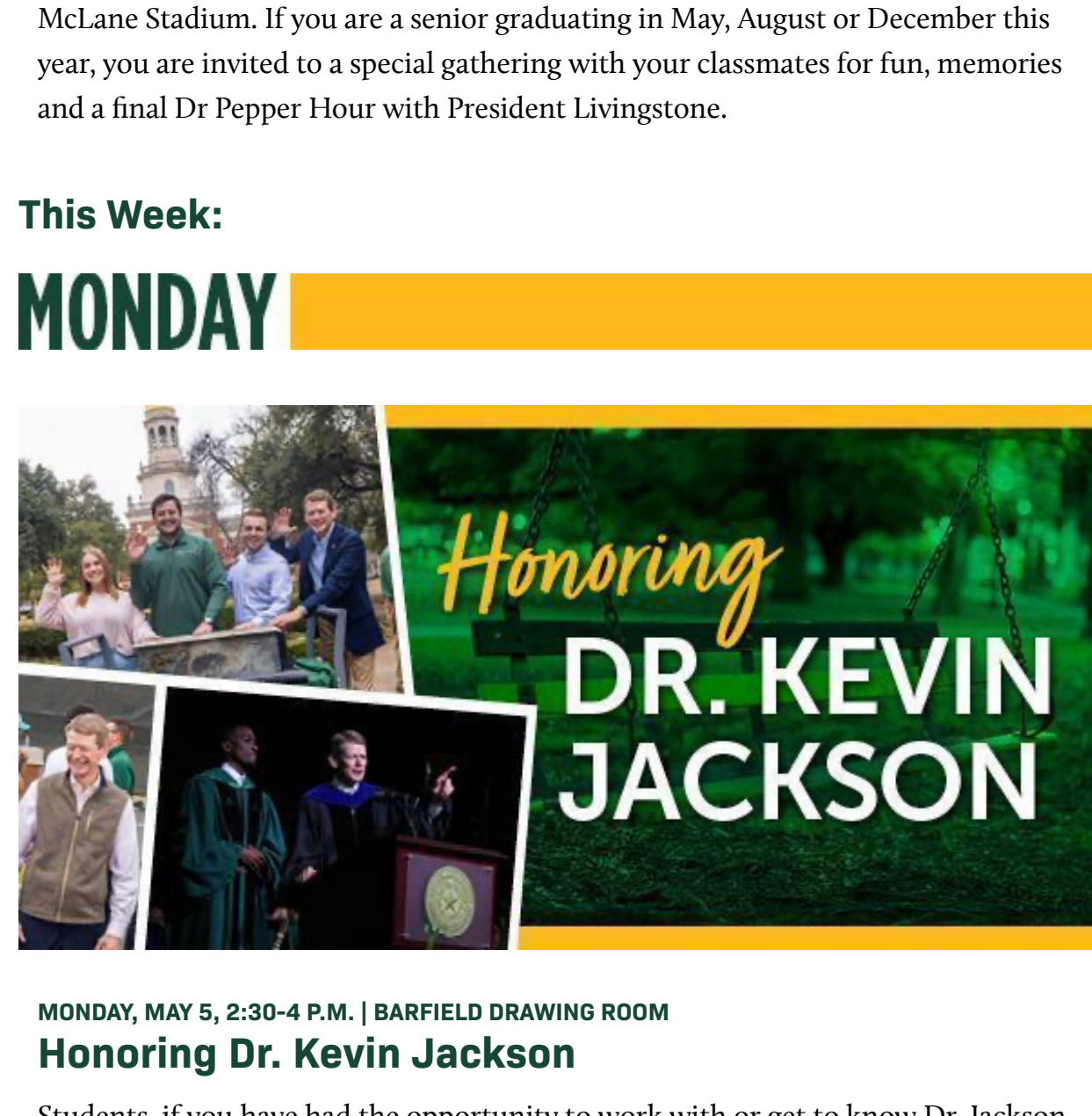

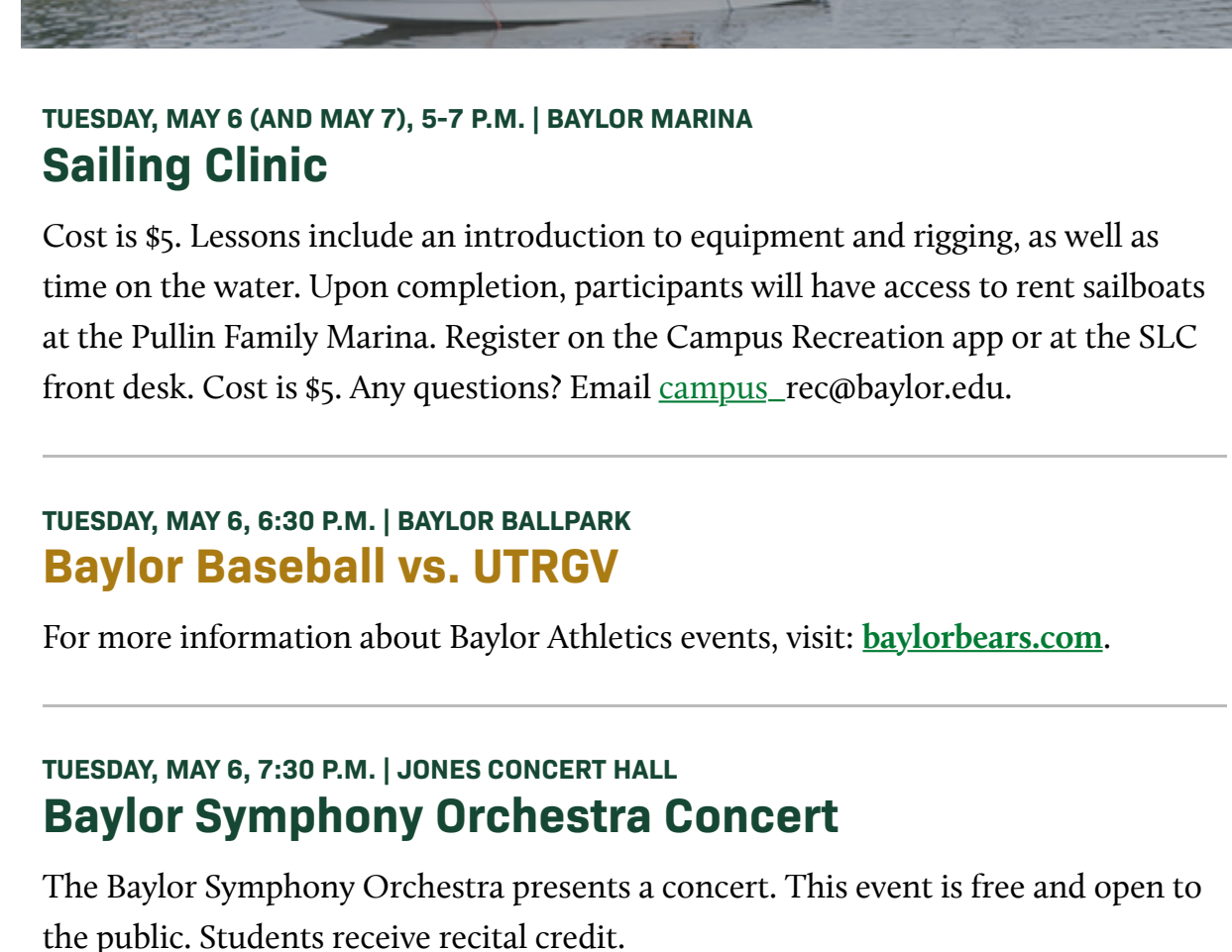

 Cost is \$5. This clinic will equip climbers with the skills and technical knowledge required to belay at the Baylor Rock.



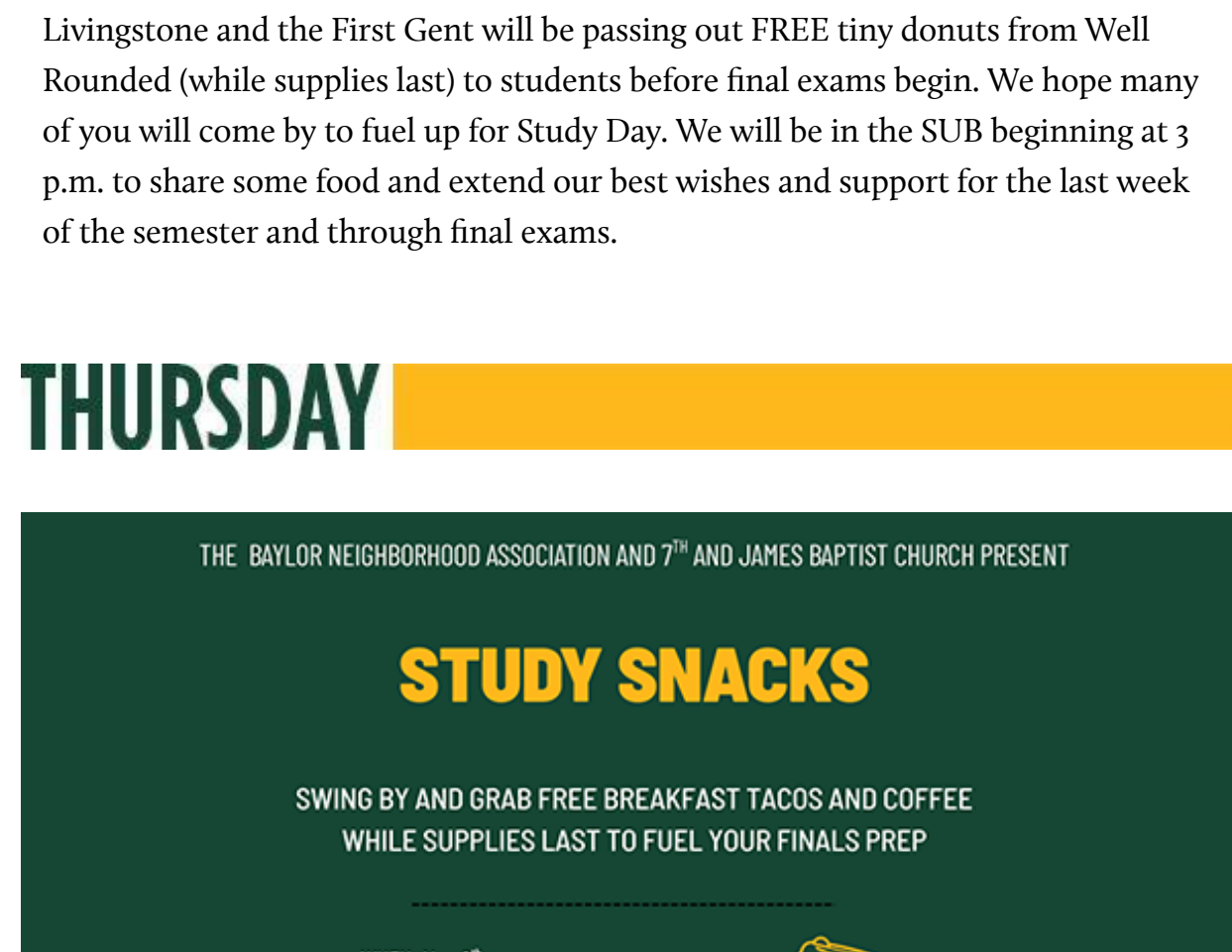

 Baylor new Mariachi Ensemble presents a concert. This event is free and open to the public.

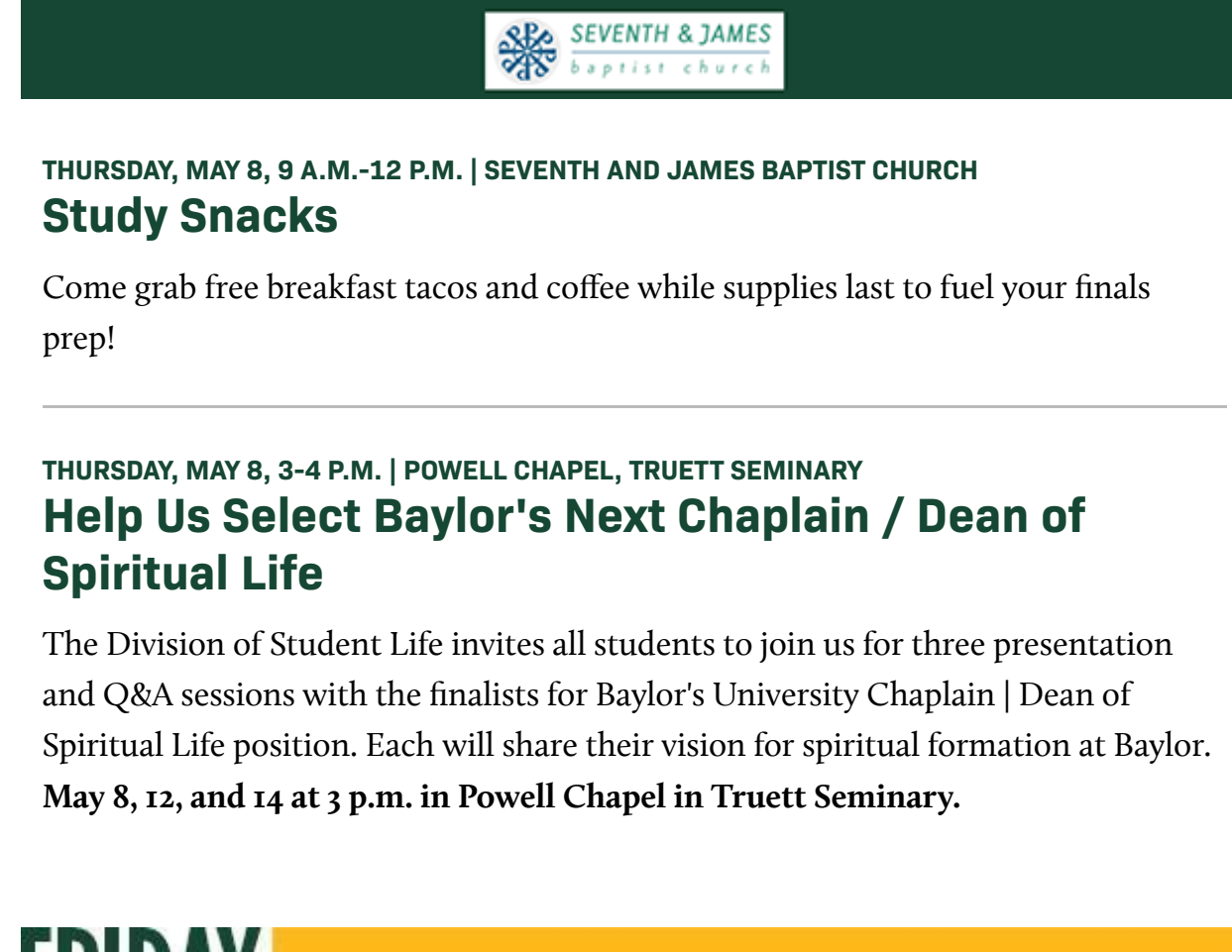

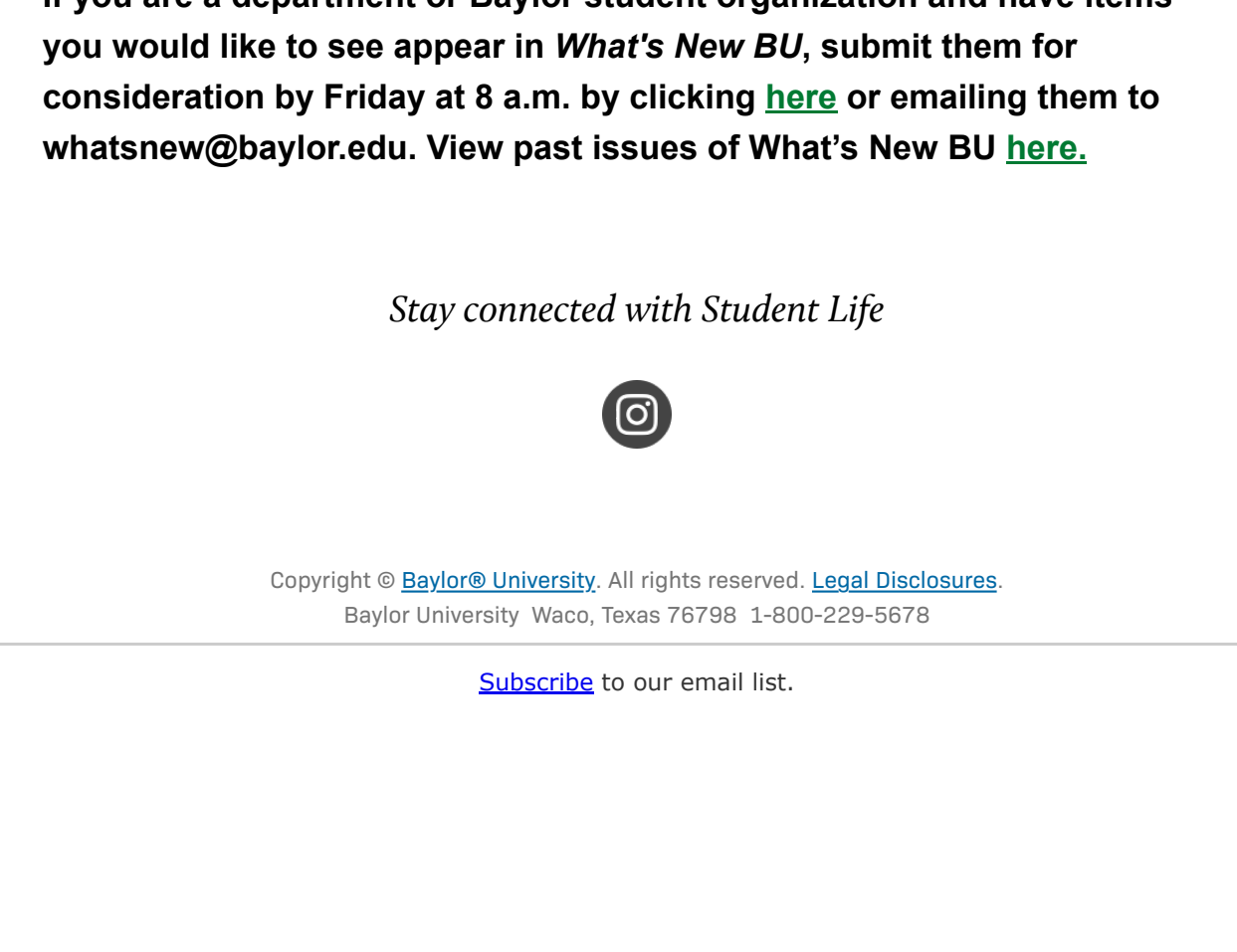
The Repurposing of Brooks Great Hall
 Since 2007, the Great Hall inside Brooks Residential College has provided a unique dining experience for the Brooks community and other Baylor students, faculty and staff. However, a recent internal review has revealed that fewer and fewer individuals are choosing to eat at Brooks. In fact, less than 10 percent of campus dining is delivered in the Great Hall, while the costs to operate the facility as a fulltime dining hall continue to increase.

As a result, and as a tangible demonstration of Baylor's commitment to being a good steward of student tuition dollars, the decision has been made to repurpose the Brooks Great Hall away from dining, effective at the end of lunch service on May 14.
